GENERAL PERMIT - RIGHT-OF-WAY USE

APPLICANT: Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company
1260 Fulton Avenue
Sacramento, California 95825

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:
An 0.014-acre area of submerged lands in
the Mokelumne River at Benson Ferry Bridge
near Thornton, Sacramento and San Joaquin
Counties.

LAND USE: Construction, operation and maintenance
of telephone and telegraph facilities.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:
Special: Continuous use plus one
year from September 22,
1981.

CONSIDERATION: Exempt by law, Public Utilities Code 7901.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:
Pursuant to 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2005.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:
Applicant is permittee of upland.
Filing fee and processing costs have been
received.

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OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$100.
2. An EIR is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15103, Class 3(d), which exempts new construction of small structures.
3. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class B, which authorizes Limited Use.

Staff has coordinated this project with those agencies and organizations which nominated the site as containing significant environmental values. They have found this project to be compatible with their nomination.

4. At the September, 1981, meeting the Commission concurred in the issuance of a Letter of Permission to PT and T to enter upon the lands described here in for a period of 60 days to construct, operate and maintain these telephone and telegraph facilities.

APPROVALS REQUIRED AND OBTAINED:

This facility is subject to the jurisdiction of the United States Army Corps of Engineers, California Department of Fish and Game, California Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board, California Reclamation Board and the Counties of Sacramento and San Joaquin. The proposed permit is conditioned on the approval of all agencies having jurisdiction.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. DETERMINE THAT AN ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENT HAS NOT BEEN PREPARED FOR THIS ACTIVITY AS SUCH DOCUMENT IS NOT REQUIRED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF P.R.C. 21084, 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15100 ET SEQ., AND 2 CAL. ADM. CODE 2907.

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2. FIND THAT GRANTING OF THE PERMIT WILL HAVE NO SIGNIFICANT EFFECT UPON ENVIRONMENTAL CHARACTERISTICS IDENTIFIED PURSUANT TO SECTION 6370.1, OF THE P.R.C.
3. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO PACIFIC TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY OF A CONTINUOUS USE PLUS ONE YEAR GENERAL PERMIT - RIGHT-OF-WAY USE FROM SEPTEMBER 22, 1981, WHICH IS EXEMPT FROM CONSIDERATION PURSUANT TO P.U.C. 7901, FOR CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH FACILITIES OVER, ACROSS AND UNDER THE LAND DELINEATED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.
