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ACCEPTANCE OF LAND DONATION CITY OF ARCATA, HUMBOLDT COUNTY

Murrish and Associates of Eureka as agent for Wendell Wyatt trustee for George Steven Van Vleet, et al. has approached the staff, offering to donate to the State $31 \pm$ acres at Arcata, Humboldt County.

The property, an old mill site, is irregular in shape, having access to South G, H and I Streets in Arcata. South G Street is old Highway 101. Significant portions (approximately 40 percent) of the property was in $\log$ ponds which have been identified as important wildlife habitat by the Department of Fish and Game and the Coastal Comaission.

The Coastal Conservancy's Arcata Marsh restorations project is immediately west across I Street from the parcel.

The property was appraised August 31, 1981 by an indepenãent appraiser, who has an MAI designation, at $\$ 225,000$. Neither the staff of the Commission nor the Attorney General has made a full appraisal of the property, but it is felt that this value is reasonable.

The property consists of Humboldt County Assessor's parcels 503-241-01, 503-241-05, 503-241-06 and 503-241-16 and is moze particularly described in Exhibit "B" hereto. Title stems from swamp and overfilow patents, although Butcher Slough which may have been natura? and tidal, runs along the easterly boundary of the parcel.

The staff has no recommended plan for the parcel, but the donor, because of tax reasons, wants to gift the property before December 31, 1981 .

## ILAND DESCRIPTITON

BEGINNING in the center of Butcher slough at a point which is distant 300 feet north from the quarter section Iine forming the south line of the northeast quarter of section 32. Township 6 North, Range 1 East. Humbold Meriaian;
thence parallel to saia quarter section inne north 89 degrees 59 minutes west 803.8 feet, more or less, to the eest line of the Iailioad right of way of the Arcata and Mad River RaiIroad Company as defined in deed Eroth Elias Sharp dated Jenuary 8,1876 ana recoraled in the offiće of the County Recorder of Humboldt County in Book "w" of Deeds. Page 578;
thence south 23 degrees 45 minutes west 35.6 feet to the north point of $e$ parcel of land conveyed by william M. Campbell to California and Northern Railway Company by deed dated November 1, 1901 and recorded in said Recorder:s office in Book 77 of Deeds, Page 75;
thence along the easterly line of said parcel south 13 degrees 39 minutes west 27.5 .7 feet, more or less, to the southeast corner of said parcel, which corner is situated on the above mentionea quarter section inne;
thence south 89 deyrees 59 minutes east on the quarter section line to the east line of the railroad right of way conveyed by R. W. Bull and wife to R. H. Emmerson ana wife by deed recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Eumboldt County, California in Book 5 of official Records, Page 110;
thence following said east line south 11 degrees 33 minutes west 94.7 feet to the intersection of said east line with the east line of the right of way of the Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company:
thence southerly following the easterly line of the railroad right of way to a point, this point is on a prolongation easteriy of the southerly line of the existing sewage disposal plant sludge beds, and is on the north line of the road leading to the Arcata Sewage Disposal Plant;
thence north 57 degrees $40 \frac{1}{4}$ minutes east along the said prolongation and the nortio line of said road 34.58 feet to the west line of Highway 101; thence northerly along the highway following the curve: thereof, 154.44 feet to the end of the curve;
thence north 15 degrees 27 minutes west along: the highway 484.72 feet:
thence north 0 degrees 12 minutes east along the highway 231.9 feet;

thence north 15 degrees 50 minutes east 890.13 feet along the highway to its intersection with the eastern terminus of the curve in the south end of the south line of the extension of "H" Street in the City of Arcata, as said extension was conveyed to the County of Humboldt by deed recorded. September 22, 1934 in Book 216 of Deeds, page 159, Humboldt County Records;
thence still along said line of "H" Street extension in a northerly direction to a point that is distant 300 feet northerly along said street from the quarter section line first above mentionea;
thence parallel with said quarter section line to the miadle of butcher slough in a westerly direction; and thence northerly on same to the point of beginning.
ALSO, the right for an electric power line of poies and wires extending from the north line of the above described land north across the next 300 foot strip; and
thence northeasterly on a line as near as practicable to the west line of the Axel Anderson Tract of land to a connection with fower lines in "X" Street near Fourth Street in Arcata, being the same right granted to R. H. Emmerson and wife dated June $1 \varepsilon$, 1946 and reccraded in the Recorder's Office of Humbolat County, California on February 13, 1947.
also, the right of way to construct, maintain and use a single track railroad spur to connect between the Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company's main line south of Ancata and the land of grantors sittuated in the southeast corner of the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter of said Section 32, along the route set forth in the deed for same executed by Ralph W. Bull and wife to R. F. Emmerson and wife recorded February 13, 1947 in Bcok 5 of Official Records, Page 110, Hamboldt County Records.
