GENERAL PERMIT - PUBLIC AGENCY USE

APPLICANT: County of San Joaquin
4520 W. Eight Mile Road
Stockton, California 95209

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:
Two circular 0.007-acre parcels totalling
0.014 acre of tide and submerged lands
in the San Joaquin River near Lathrop,
San Joaquin County.

LAND USE: Maintenance of two existing buoys located
adjacent to Dos Reis Angling Access, a
free public fishing access development.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:
Initial period: 27 years from April 27,
1982.

CONSIDERATION: The public use and benefit with the State
reserving the right at any time to set
a monetary rental if the Commission finds
such action to be in the State's best interest.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:
Pursuant to 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2003.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:
Applicant is owner and permittee of upland.
Filing fee and processing costs have been
received.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:
1. The annual rental value of the site
is estimated to be \$50.

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2. This project is exempt from CEQA in that they are existing facilities in an acceptable state of repair, 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905, Class 1(2).
3. The project is situated on lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class B, which authorizes Limited Use.

The project as proposed will not have a significant effect upon the identified environmental values. This is an existing facility for which no adverse comments have been received.

APPROVALS REQUIRED AND OBTAINED:

These facilities are subject to the jurisdiction of the United States Army Corps of Engineers, California Department of Fish and Game, California Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board, California Reclamation Board and the County of San Joaquin. The proposed permit is conditioned on the approval of all agencies having jurisdiction.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. DETERMINE THAT AN ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENT HAS NOT BEEN PREPARED FOR THIS ACTIVITY AS SUCH DOCUMENT IS NOT REQUIRED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF P.R.C. 21084, 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15100 ET SEQ., AND 2 CAL. ADM. CODE 2905; AND FIND THAT THE PROJECT IS CONSISTENT WITH ITS USE CLASSIFICATION.
2. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO THE COUNTY OF SAN JOAQUIN OF A 27-YEAR GENERAL PERMIT - PUBLIC AGENCY USE FROM APRIL 27, 1982; IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC USE AND BENEFIT WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT AT ANY TIME TO SET A MONETARY RENTAL IF THE COMMISSION FINDS SUCH ACTION TO BE IN THE STATE'S BEST INTEREST; FOR MAINTENANCE OF TWO EXISTING SPEED REGULATION BUOYS ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

LAND DESCRIPTION

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Two circular parcels of submerged land 20 feet in diameter in the bed of the San Joaquin River westerly of Lathrop, San Joaquin County, California, the center points of said parcels have approximate California Coordinate System Zone 3 coordinates of:

1. Northerly parcel
x = 1,765,920 y = 485,620
2. Southerly parcel
x = 1,765,960 y = 485,220

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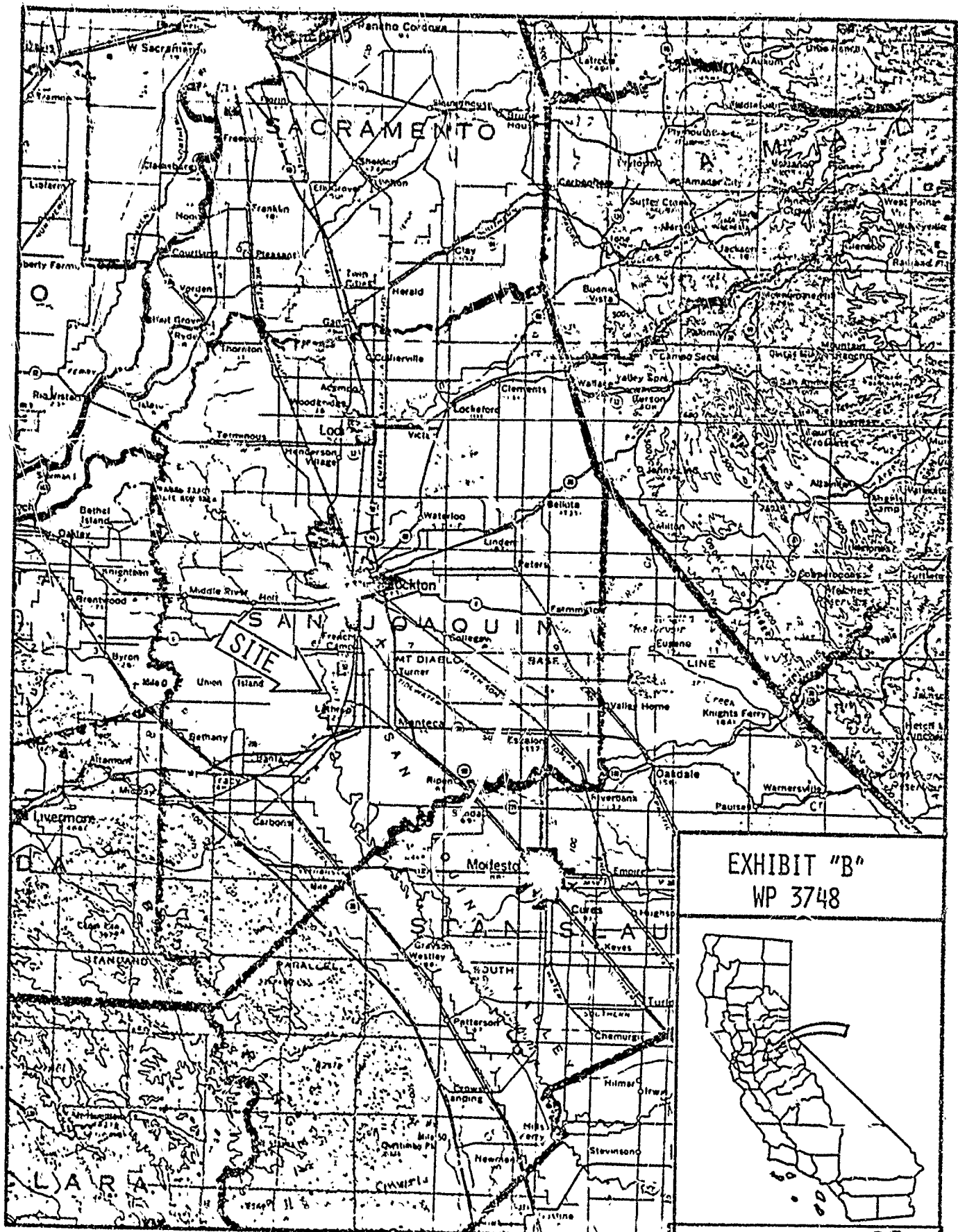
