GENERAL LEASE - COMMERCIAL USE

LESSEE: Earl Maben

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:
A 0.175-acre parcel of tide and submerged
land, located in the Sacramento River near
Ryde, Sacramento County.

LAND USE: Maintenance and operation of an existing
docking facility.

TERMS OF ORIGINAL LEASE:

Initial period: 15 years from December 1,
1974.

Renewal options: One successive period
of ten years.

Surety bond: \$1,000.

Public liability insurance: Combined single
limit coverage of \$300,000.

Consideration: \$225 per annum; five-year
rent review.

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE:

Initial period: 15 years from December 1, 1982.

Surety bond: \$1,000.

Public liability insurance: Combined single limit coverage of \$300,000.

CONSIDERATION: \$267.75 per annum with the State reserving the right to fix a different rental on each fifth anniversary of the lease.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:

Nine percent of appraised value, pursuant to 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2003.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Applicant is owner of upland.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

2. The activity is situated on lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1 and is classified in a use category "B" which authorizes Limited Use. The activity as proposed will not have a significant effect upon the identified environmental values.

1. DETERMINE THAT AN ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENT HAS NOT BEEN PREPARED FOR THIS ACTIVITY AS SUCH DOCUMENT IS NOT REQUIRED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF P.R.C. 21065, 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15057 AND 15060; AND FIND THAT THE ACTIVITY IS CONSISTENT WITH ITS USE CLASSIFICATION.
2. AUTHORIZE TERMINATION OF ORIGINAL LEASE PRC 5226.1, SAID TERMINATION TO BE EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 30, 1982 AND ISSUANCE TO EARL MABEN OF A 15-YEAR GENERAL LEASE - COMMERCIAL USE FROM DECEMBER 1, 1982, IN CONSIDERATION OF ANNUAL RENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$267.75, WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT TO FIX A DIFFERENT RENTAL ON EACH FIFTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE LEASE; PROVISION OF A \$1,000 SURETY BOND; PROVISION OF PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR COMBINED SINGLE LIMIT COVERAGE OF \$300,000; FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF AN EXISTING DOCKING FACILITY ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

EXHIBIT "A"

LAND DESCRIPTION

PRC 5226

A parcel of tide and submerged land in the bed of the Sacramento River, in protracted Section 4, T4N, R4E, MDM, County of Sacramento, State of California, described as follows:

COMMENCING at the northwest corner of that tract of land conveyed to Harry A. Sergent, Jennie E. Sergent, Warren E. Sergent, and Karen S. Sergent by Grant Deed dated October 16, 1970, and recorded November 30, 1970, in Book 70-11-30, page 246, of the Official Records of Sacramento County, California; thence S 0° 54' 30" E 10 feet; thence N 89° 05' 30" E parallel with and 10 feet southerly, measured at right angles to the northerly boundary of the aforementioned tract of land, 320 feet and S 00° 54' 30" E 103 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING; thence the following eight courses:

1. N 89° 05' 30" E 64 feet;
2. N 00° 54' 30" W 103 feet;
3. N 89° 05' 30" E 28 feet;
4. S 00° 54' 30" E 230 feet;
5. S 89° 05' 30" W 28 feet;
6. N 00° 54' 30" W 103 feet;
7. S 89° 05' 30" W 64 feet; and
8. N 00° 54' 30" W 14 feet to the point of beginning.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary high water mark of the Sacramento River.

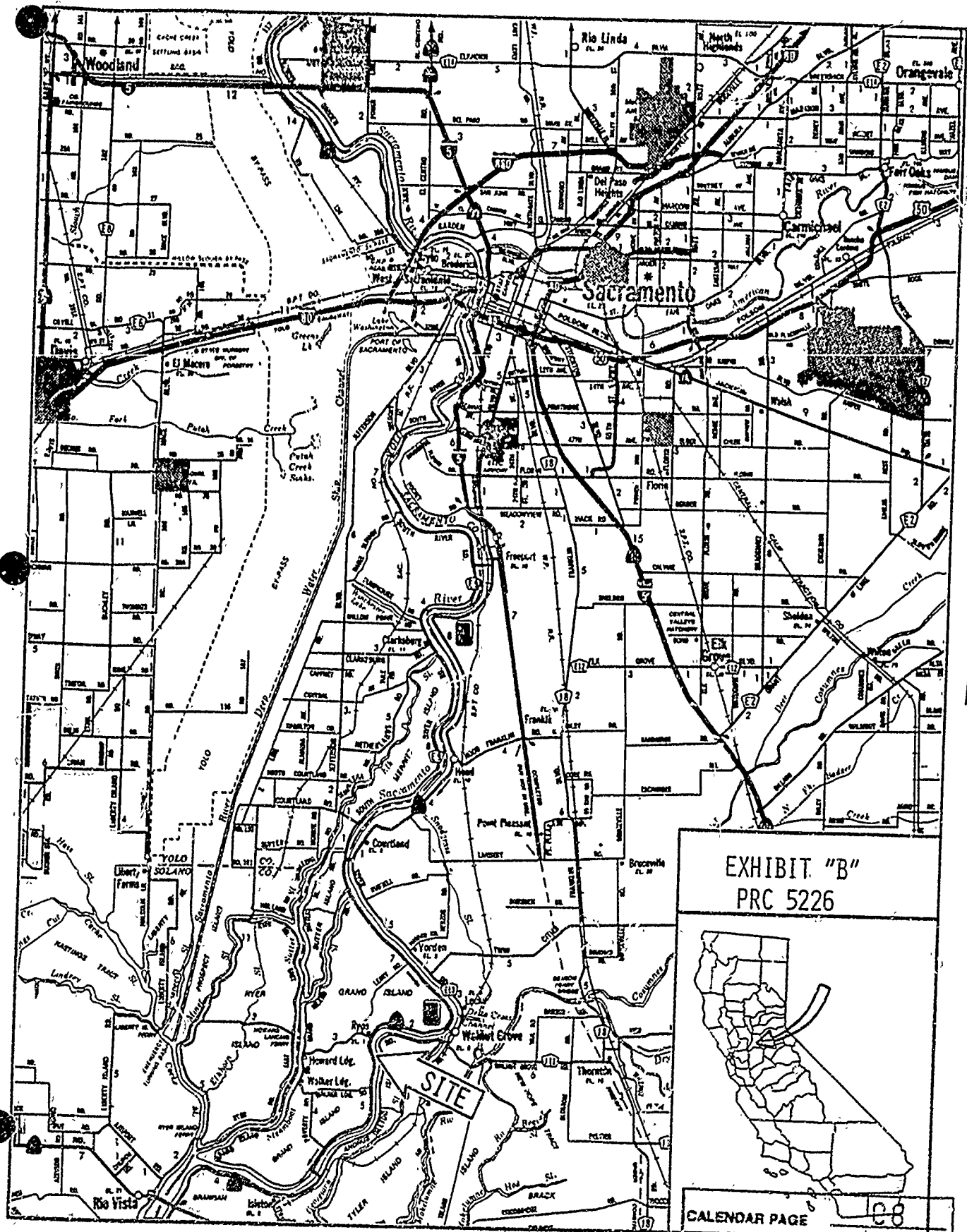
