STATUS OF MAJOR LITIGATION

N. Gregory Taylor, Assistant Attorney General, stated that a petition had been received from the Catalina Marine Services Corporation raising allegations regarding the number of mooring buoys which actually exist at Catalina. In light of the charges made in the petition and the Commission's decision that fair rental be received based upon actual knowledge of what exists, and because of potential litigation, the Commission decided in Executive Session that the receipt of bids, scheduled for 2:00 p.m., October 8, 1982, would be suspended. The Executive Officer and staff are instructed to undertake an investigation of the charges made in the petition and to report back to the Commission at the October 28, 1982 regular meeting.
