OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- The applicant proposes to retain an armored cable 95 miles in length, lying on the Pacific Ocean floor off Point Arena (Mendocino County). Because the subject cable was installed pre-1973, it is exempted from the California Coastal Commission permitting process. The cable was originally installed in conjunction with Lamont-Doherty Geological Observatory of Columbia University but is now within the jurisdiction of the applicant.
- The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$427.
- This project is exempt from CEQA because it is within the purview of 2 Cal. 3. Adm. Code, Section 2905, Class 1.
- This project is situated on land identified as possessing environmental values in that the State Lands Commission stated all waterways under the Commission's jurisdiction have environmental significance. Staff finds this project to be compatible with Commission policy.

AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO THE OFFICE OF NAVAL RESEARCH OF A 49-YEAR GENERAL PERMIT PUBLIC AGENCY USE, FROM JULY 1, 1982; IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC USE WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT AT ANY TIME TO SET A MONETARY RENTAL IF THE COMMISSION FINDS SUCH ACTION TO BE IN THE STATE'S BEST INTEREST; FOR USE AND MAINTENANCE OF A SUBMARINE ARMORED CABLE ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY NUFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.
