ACCEPTANCE OF A QUITCLAIM DEED AND
TERMINATION OF LEASE

APPLICANT: Southern Pacific Transportation Company
One Market Street
San Francisco, California 94105

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:
A 1.91-acre parcel, more or less, of State
school land, near Herlong, in Lassen County.

LAND USE: The construction of a power distribution
line.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. The subject property is covered by
two separate leases. The first involves
the United States Army's occupation
of the lands since February 1, 1942
and is identified as lease PRC 514.2
which commenced on May 30, 1950. Paragraph
5 of the lease states:

A 1

S 1

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"The Government shall have the right, during the existence of this lease to attach fixtures, and erect structures or signs, in or upon the premises hereby leased, which fixtures and structures, or signs, so placed in, upon or attached to the said premises shall be and remain the property of the Government and may be removed or otherwise disposed of by the Government".

The second, involves the Southern Pacific Transportation Company Right-of-Way lease which commenced on April 1, 1968 and will terminate on June 30, 1985. Paragraph 14 of the lease requires all improvements erected shall be removed by Lessee, at Lessee's sole expense and risk, within 90 days of lease termination.

The Southern Pacific Transportation Company desires to terminate their lease and has provided the Commission with a Quitclaim Deed (see Exhibit "C"). The United States Army desires that the pole line be left in place and has agreed that all property installed by Southern Pacific is deemed to have become the property of the United States Army (see Exhibit "D").

Since the United States Army currently leases the subject property and is willing to assume responsibility for the improvements and Southern Pacific desires to divest itself of this lease, it is recommended that the Commission accept the Quitclaim Deed and terminate "Southern Pacific's" lease PRC 4119.2.

2. This project is exempt from CEQA because it lacks a significant environmental effect pursuant to P.R.C. 21100, 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15060.
3. The project is situated on lands not identified as possessing significant

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environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1. A staff review of available environmental information indicates no reason to identify the subject school land parcel as having such values at this time.

2. FIND THAT THIS ACTIVITY IS NOT SITUATED ON LANDS IDENTIFIED AS POSSESSING SIGNIFICANT ENVIRONMENTAL VALUES.
3. AUTHORIZE THE ACCEPTANCE OF LEASE QUITCLAIM DEED DATED OCTOBER 24, 1982, CURRENTLY ON FILE IN THE OFFICE OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION AND TERMINATE LEASE PRC 4119.2, EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 24, 1982.

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EXHIBIT "A"

LAND DESCRIPTION

PRC 4119.2

A parcel of land in Lassen County, State of California, situated in the south half of the southeast quarter of Section 24 and the south half of Section 25, T28N, R16E, MDM; said parcel being a strip of land 10 feet in width lying 5 feet on each side of the following described centerline:

COMMENCING at the northwest corner of said Section 24 thence S 88° 47' 45" E 1804.5 feet; thence S 60° 20' 45" E 1902.6 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence S 00° 54' 15" E 8301.8 feet to the end of the herein described centerline.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying within the north half of Section 25, T28N, R16E, MDM

ALSO EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying within Section 24 lying outside of the south half of the southeast quarter of said Section 24, T28N, R16E, MDM.

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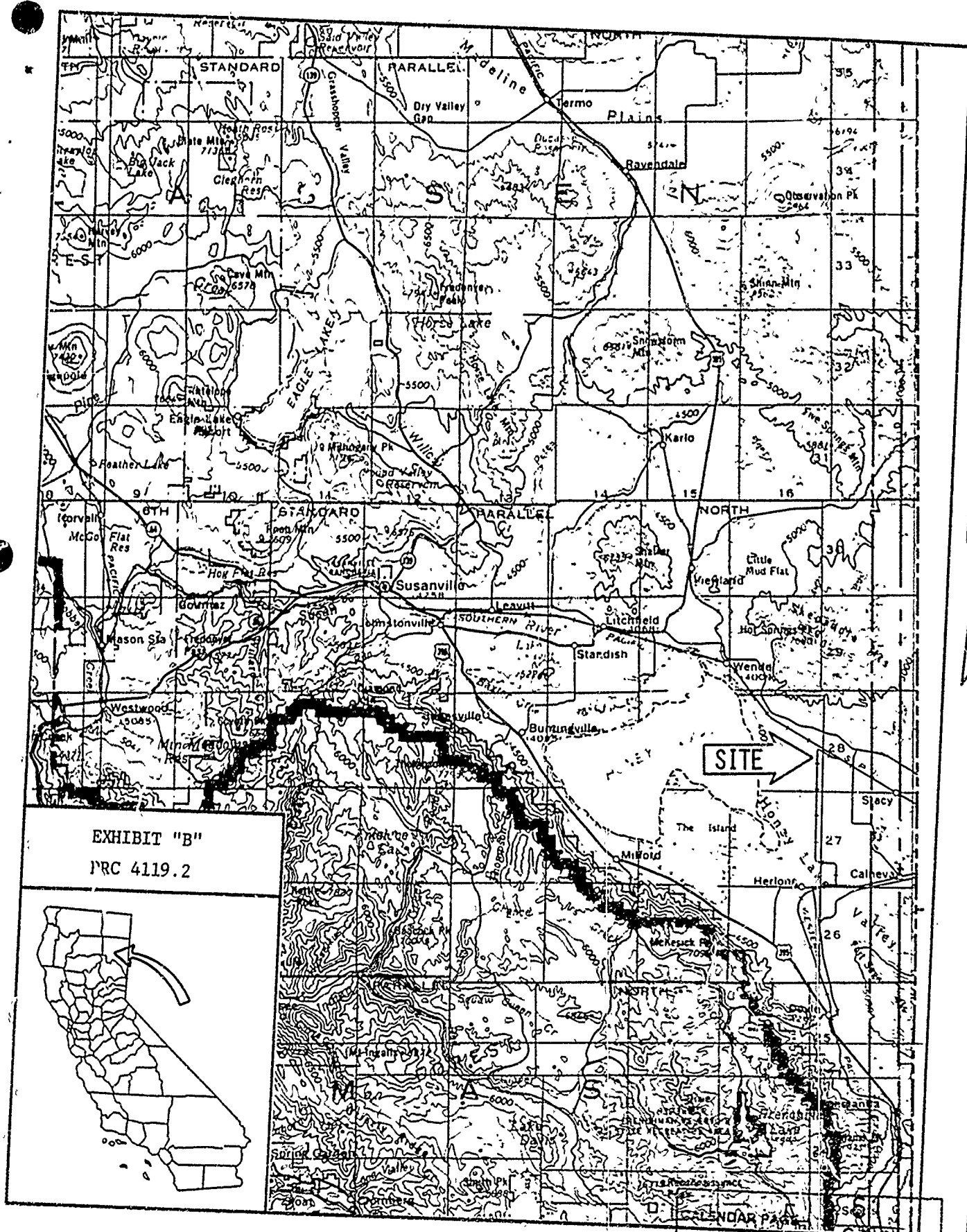

LEASE QUITCLAIM DEED

WHEREAS, pursuant to lease renewal designated PRC 4119.2 entered into on May 14, 1976, by and between the State of California, acting by and through the State Lands Commission, as Lessor, and the Southern Pacific Transportation Company as Lessee, said Lessee was granted for a term of ten (10) years commencing July 1, 1975, the right to use the property herein described, for certain purposes specified in said lease; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Paragraph 15, of said lease renewal, Lessee agreed to execute and deliver to State a good and sufficient quitclaim deed on the last day of said term or sooner termination of said lease.

NOW THEREFORE, the Southern Pacific Transportation Company does hereby remise, release and forever quitclaim unto the State of California any and all right, claim, title or interest arising by virtue of or pursuant to that certain lease renewal designated PRC 4119.2 entered into on May 14, 1976, respecting lands located in Lassen County, State of California, and described in Exhibit "A" attached and by reference made a part hereof.

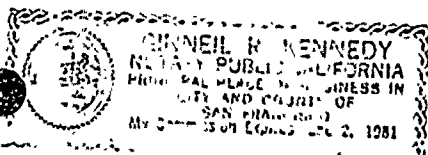
