TERMINATION OF APPLICATION OF SURFACE OWNERS TO
PROSPECT FOR MINERALS OTHER THAN
OIL AND GAS AND GEOTHERMAL RESOURCES
ON MINERALS RESERVED STATE SCHOOL LAND,
SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

640 acres of State School Land patented
in 1958 with 100 percent minerals reserved
to the State. Section 16, T10N, R2E, SBB&M.
San Bernardino County near Yermo. The north
half of the surface is owned by Carmona,
the south half is owned by Rodda.

BACKGROUND:

On February 16, 1978, staff received an
inquiry from U. S. Borax concerning application
for a prospecting permit on the subject
parcel of State school land with the surface
rights owned by Carmona and Rodda.

Carmona and Rodda were notified on March 10,
1978, of their preferential right to prospect
the parcel under P.R.C. Section 6893. The
required application forms were sent on
this date.

Rodda, representing both surface owners, responded on March 17, 1978, indicating they would exercise their preferential rights to apply for a prospecting permit.

After two and one-half years of repeated attempts to obtain sufficient information to process the application, staff informed Rodda and the Carmona on October 31, 1980 that their application had lapsed due to failure to submit the required information in a timely manner. Refund checks for the acreage deposit were sent to the applicants. The checks were cashed and no further communication was received.

U.S. Borax and Chemical Corporation has subsequently reaffirmed their application for a prospecting permit on the subject land and their application is being processed.

OTHER INFORMATION:

1. This action is exempt from CEQA because it is not a project. (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15060).

2. FIND THAT THE PREFERENTIAL RIGHTS OF THE SURFACE OWNERS, GEORGE H. RODDA, JR. AND ALBERT AND MARCIA CARMONA, TO FILE AN APPLICATION FOR A PROSPECTING PERMIT HAVE CEASED AND ARE TERMINATED BY ACTION OF THE APPLICANTS AND FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS, RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR APPLYING FOR SUCH PERMIT.
3. AUTHORIZE STAFF TO PROCEED WITH THE ORIGINAL APPLICANT, U.S. BORAX AND CHEMICAL CORPORATION.
