A 0.044-acre parcel of tide and submerged land, located in Corte Madera Creek near

Larkspur, Marin County.

LAND USE:

Stabilization, bank protection, and construction

and maintenance of a private boat dock.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$212.30.
- 2. The bank protection and the boat dock are being combined in one permit for ease of record keeping and to eliminate the issuance of two separate permits for the same area.
- 3. Staff feels that bank protection at this location will be of mutual benefit to both the public and applicant. The bank will have additional protection from high water erosion of material at no expense to the public. The applicant will benefit from protection of the existing homesite.
- 4. This project is exempt from CEQA because it involves new construction of a dock occupying less than 3,000 square feet; and the minor alteration to land for a protective structure. Cal. Adm. Code 2905, Class 3 and Class 4.
- 5. The project is situated on lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category "C" which authorizes Multiple Use. The project as proposed will not have a significant effect upon the identified environmental values.


