- 1. The project consists of constructing approximately one-quarter mile of road across State school land. The proposed road will benefit both the State and Southern Pacific by providing access to parcels in their respective ownerships.
- 2. A Negative Declaration No. 316 was prepared and circulated, pursuant to CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines, no adverse comments were received through such circulation.
- 3. The project is situated on lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in use category "A" which authorizes Restricted Use. The project as proposed will not have a significant effect upon the identified environmental values.




