DREDGING PERMIT

APPLICANT:

County of Marin

Department of Parks and Rocreation

Civic Center

San Rafael, California 94903

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

Tide and submerged lands in the bed of Pine Gulch Creek near Bolinas Bay, Marin

County, California.

LAND USE:

Dredge a total of 3,000 cubic yards of

material to re-open a natural channel obstructed

by flooding, in Pine Gulch Creek. Spoils are to be placed adjacent to the creek.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:

Iniitial period: One year from January 1,

1983.

CONSIDERATION:

No royalty to be charged for spoils placed adjacent to the creek which is on county

land.

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PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES: Filing fee has been received.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:

A. P.R.C. 6303, 6370, 21065, 21084. B. 2 Cal. Adm. Code, 2905, 2951-2954 14 Cal. Adm. Code, 15000, ET SEQ., 15104(g).

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- The Marin County Department of Parks and Recreation has applied for a permit to dredge 3,000 cubic yards of sediment from the channel of Pine Gulch Creek to remove sediments brought in by the January 1982 storms. Spoils will be placed on lands owned by the county adjacent to the stream. No royalty will be charged for spoils placed on publicly owned lands.
- The project is exempt from CEQA under 14 Cal. Adm. Code, 15104(g). The project is maintenance dredging with authorized disposal of spoils.
- This project is situated on State lands identified as possessing significant environmental value pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1 and is classified in use Category Class "B", Limited Use. Staff has coordinated this project with those agencies and organizations which nominated the site as containing significant environmental values. They have found this project to be compatible with their nomination.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

DETERMINE THAT AN ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENT HAS NOT BEEN PREPARED FOR THIS ACTIVITY AS SUCH DOCUMENT IS NOT REQUIRED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF P.R.C. 21084, 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15100, ET SEQ., AND 2 CAL. ADM. CODE 2905 (CATEGORICAL EXEMPTIONS) AND FIND THAT THIS ACTIVITY

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IS COMPATIBLE WITH ITS USE CLASSIFICATION ASSIGNED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF PRC 6370, ET SEQ.

2. AUTHORIZE THE STAFF OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION TO ISSUE TO THE COUNTY OF MARIN DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION THE PERMIT ON FILE IN THE OFFICE OF THE COMMISSION. THE PERMIT TERM WILL BE FOR ONE YEAR FROM JANUARY 1, 1983. NO ROYALTY WILL BE CHARGED FOR SPOILS PLACED ON PUBLICLY OWNED LANDS. A ROYALTY OF \$0.15 PER CUBIC YARD IS TO BE CHARGED FOR SPOILS PLACED AT A CORPS OF ENGINEERS DISPOSAL SITE, AND A ROYALTY OF \$0.25 PER CUBIC YARD IS TO BE CHARGED FOR SPOILS PLACED ON PRIVATE PROPERTY OR SOLD FOR COMMERCIAL BENEFIT. THE PERMIT WILL ALLOW FOR THE REMOVAL OF A MAXIMUM OF 3,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MINERALS OTHER THAN OIL, GAS AND GEOTHERMAL FROM TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS IN PINE GULCH CREEK NEAR BOLINAS BAY, MARIN COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, SAID AREA AS SHOWN ON EXHIBIT "B" ATTACHED HERETO AND BY THIS REFERENCE EXPRESSLY MADE A PART HEREOF. THE MATERIAL DREDGED IS TO BE DEPOSITED ADJACENT TO THE STREAM AS APPROVED BY ALL APPLICABLE REGULATORY AGENCIES.

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
