## INCORPORATION OF TJDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS JNTO THE PROPOSEC CITY OF EAST PALO ALTO

The State Lands Commission has received from the proponents of incorporation of the new Ci.ty of East Palo Altio a request to review and approve the proposed bundaries of the now city.

This area is presently an unincorporated part of San Mateo County. A considerable portion of the proposed city is existing and historic tide and submerged lands uwned by the State of California by virtue of its sovereignty.

Pursuant to Government Code Section 35009, the Commission reviews and approves or disapproves the proposed boundaries of areas to be incorporated into new cities. In addition, the Commission, as a landowner, may object to the proposed incorporation. The staff of the Commission has reviewed the boundary description of the proposed city in accordance with the requirements of Gover ent Code Section 3500' and has found the description adequate.

Section 35009 requires that the proponents of incorporation submit the boundary description and a map of the new city

boundaries for approval by the Commission prior co filling the petition for incorporation. In this case, rowever the petition for incorporation has already been filed wich anc approved by the San Rateo Councy Local Agency Formation Commission. The San Hateo County Board of Superviso. s has scheduled a special election to be held on June 7,1983 for submission of the incorporation question to the voters.

As a result, it can be said that the application for Commission review and approval of the incorporation is not timely. However, staff is aware of no prejucice or del:riment to tae State as a result of this delay by the applicants, and has therefore treated the appiication as chowit it were timely.

Scaft has reviewed the proposed incorporation bouncary description and finds it adequate. Further, staff has found no reason ro object as a landowner to transfer of police fower from San Hateo County to the new city.
