DATED SEPTEMBER 12, 1958; AND
ISSUANCE OF A
GENERAL LEASE - COMMERCIAL USE

APPLICANT: Dale Dorn,

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:
A 0.760-acre parcel of tide and submerged
land, located in the Sacramento River,
Andrus Island, Sacramento County.

LAND USE: Boating facilities.

TERMS OF ORIGINAL LEASE:
Initial period: 15 years from December 18,
1957.
Renewal options: Two (2) successive periods
of ten (10) years each.
Surety bond: \$1,000.
Consideration: \$100 per annum.

TERMS OF PROPOSED REPLACEMENT LEASE:
Initial period: 30 years from December 18,
1982.
Surety bond: \$1,000.
Public liability insurance: Combined single
limit coverage of \$750,000.

1. Staff and lessee have agreed to replace the existing lease in order to reflect the current Commission-approved lease format, new rental, revised description and new term.

3. This activity is situated on lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category "B" which authorizes Limited Use. This activity as proposed will not have a significant effect upon the identified environmental values.

AUTHORIZE TERMINATION OF LEASE PRC 2049.1, EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 17, 1982 AND ISSUANCE TO DALE DORN, dba KO-KET RESORT OF A 30-YEAR GENERAL LEASE - COMMERCIAL USE, FROM DECEMBER 18, 1982; IN CONSIDERATION OF ANNUAL RENT IN THE AMOUNT \$1,231.20, WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT TO FIX A DIFFERENT RENTAL ON EACH FIFTH ANNI-VERSARY OF THE LEASE; PROVISION OF A \$1,000 SURETY BOND; PROVISION OF PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR COMBINED SINGLE LIMIT COVERAGE OF \$750,000; FOR EXISTING BOATING FACILITIES ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

LAND DESCRIPTION

Three parcels of tide and submerged land in the bed of the Sacramento River in Section 33, T5N, R4E, MDM, Sacramento County, California, across the river from the community of Ryde, more particularly described as follows:

PARCEL 1

COMMENCING at a 1 1/2 inch iron pipe shown on a record of survey of a portion of the property of Llewellyn A. Brown, filed as Map No. 41 of Book 4 of Surveys, Official Records of Sacramento County, said pipe lying \parallel $81^{\circ} 38' W$ 25.90 feet from the southeast corner of said survey; thence along the following six courses:

1. S $81^{\circ} 38' 00'' E$ 25.90 feet;
2. S $18^{\circ} 15' 00'' E$ 825.35 feet;
3. S $89^{\circ} 56' 00'' E$ 1711.45 feet;
4. N $10^{\circ} 14' 43'' W$ 2600.76 feet;
5. N $79^{\circ} 45' 17'' E$ 100.00 feet;
6. N $10^{\circ} 14' 43'' W$ 94.27 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING;

thence S $85^{\circ} 10' 07'' W$ 132.62 feet to a point designated "A"; thence N $7^{\circ} 29' 52'' W$ 45.40 feet; thence N $82^{\circ} 30' 08'' E$ 130.00 feet; thence S $10^{\circ} 14' 43'' E$ 51.62 feet to the point of beginning.

PARCEL 2

COMMENCING at the point designated "A" in Parcel 1 above; thence S $81^{\circ} 09' 28'' W$ 20.42 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence along the following four courses:

1. S $81^{\circ} 09' 28'' W$ 252.04 feet;
2. S $87^{\circ} 57' 16'' W$ 168.11 feet;
3. S $66^{\circ} 34' 17'' W$ 98.09 feet;
4. S $72^{\circ} 15' 19'' W$ 52.50 feet to a point designated "B";

thence along the following five courses:

5. N $22^{\circ} 33' 45'' W$ 35.84 feet;
6. N $67^{\circ} 26' 15'' E$ 153.50 feet;
7. N $87^{\circ} 02' 37'' E$ 213.28 feet;
8. N $79^{\circ} 22' 49'' E$ 211.74 feet;
9. S $10^{\circ} 37' 11'' E$ 43.02 feet to the point of beginning.

PARCEL 3

COMMENCING at the point designated "B" in Parcel 2 above; thence S $65^{\circ} 08' 28'' W$ 86.37 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence along the following eight courses:

1. S $63^{\circ} 37' 52'' W$ 24.13 feet;
2. N $32^{\circ} 14' 12'' W$ 23.53 feet;
3. S $57^{\circ} 45' 48'' W$ 42.00 feet;

4. N 32° 14' 12" W 28.00 feet;
5. N 57° 45' 48" E 130.00 feet;
6. S 32° 14' 12" E 28.00 feet;
7. S 57° 45' 48" W 64.00 feet;
8. S 32° 14' 12" E 26.00 feet to the point of beginning.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion of the above described Parcels 1, 2, and 3, lying landward of the ordinary high water mark of the Sacramento River.

The basis for bearings in this description is the description in the deed recorded in Book 983, Page 110, Official Records of Sacramento County.

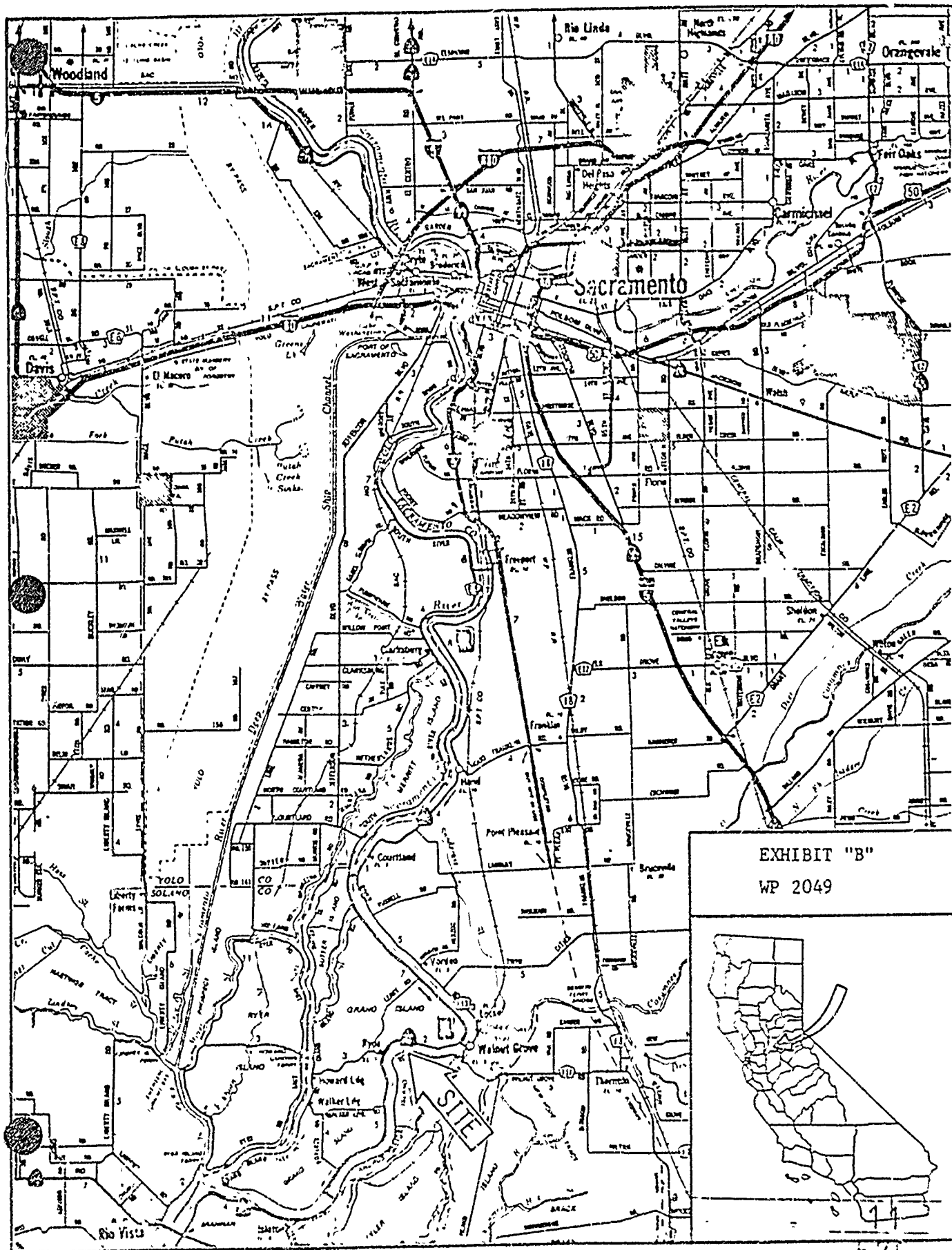
