APPLICANT: Tree Slough Farms, Inc.
P. O. Box 114
Rheem Valley, California 94570

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:
A 0.01-acre parcel of tide and submerged
land, located in Montezuma Slough at Grizzly
Island, Solano County.

LAND USE: Bulkhead structure for levee protection
and stabilization.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:
Initial period: 25 years from July 1,
1982.

CONSIDERATION: The public benefit, with the State reserving
the right at any time to set a monetary
rental if the Commission finds such action
to be in the State's best interest.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. The applicant proposes to construct a bulkhead from 14 4 x 8 redwood post pilings ringed with tires to protect the levee from boat wash and tidal action, in the Montezuma Slough. Staff believes that bank protection at this location will be of mutual benefit to both the applicant and the public. The bank will have additional protection at no cost to the public.

Staff recommends that processing expense fees be waived due to the minute size of the project and the uncertainty of the State's interest at the project site.

2. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$50.
3. This project is exempt from CEQA because it is a minor alteration to land as defined within the purview of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905, Class 4(2).
4. The project is situated on lands identified as possessing environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category "B" which authorizes Limited Use. The project as proposed will not have a significant effect upon the environmental values.

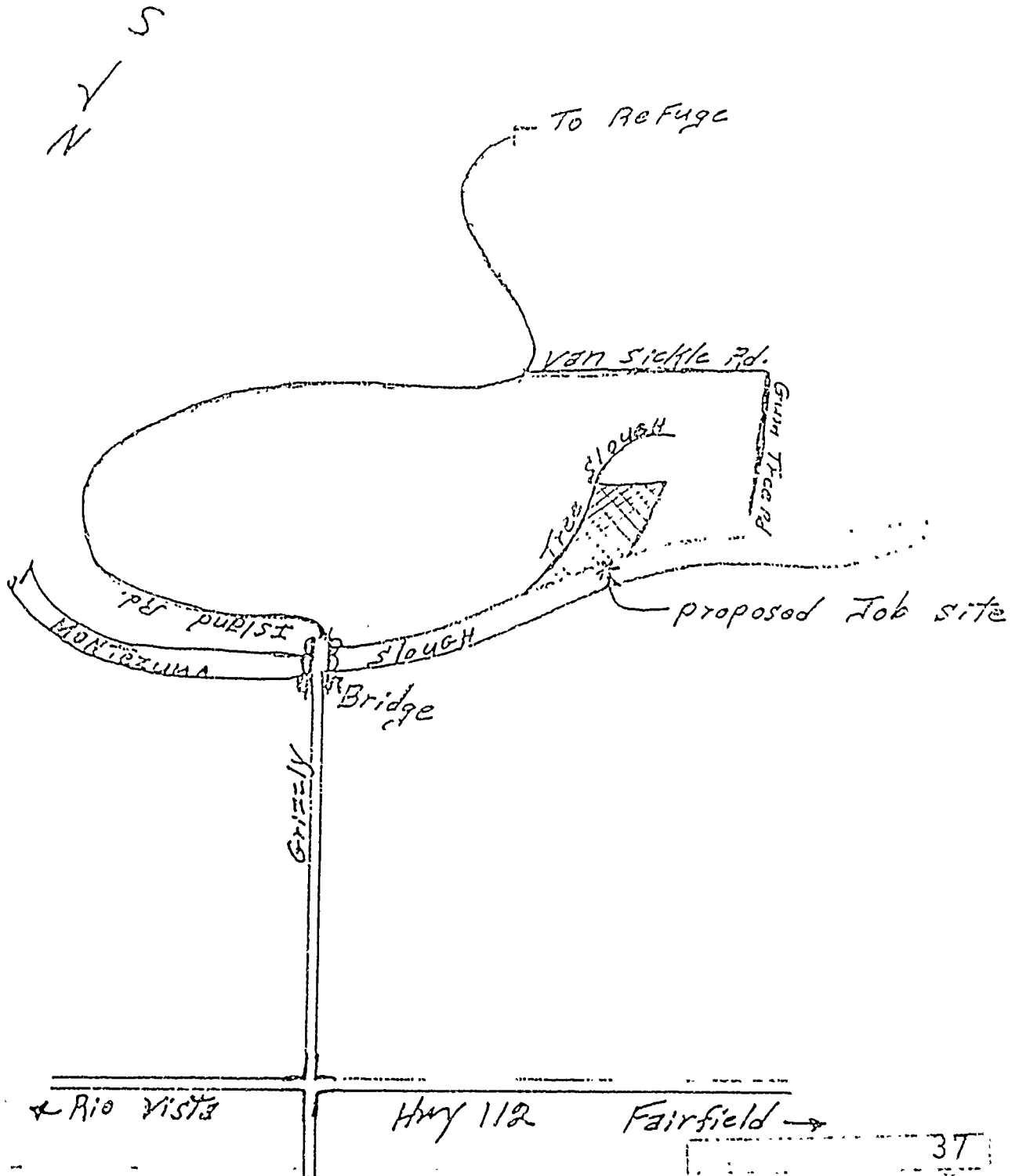

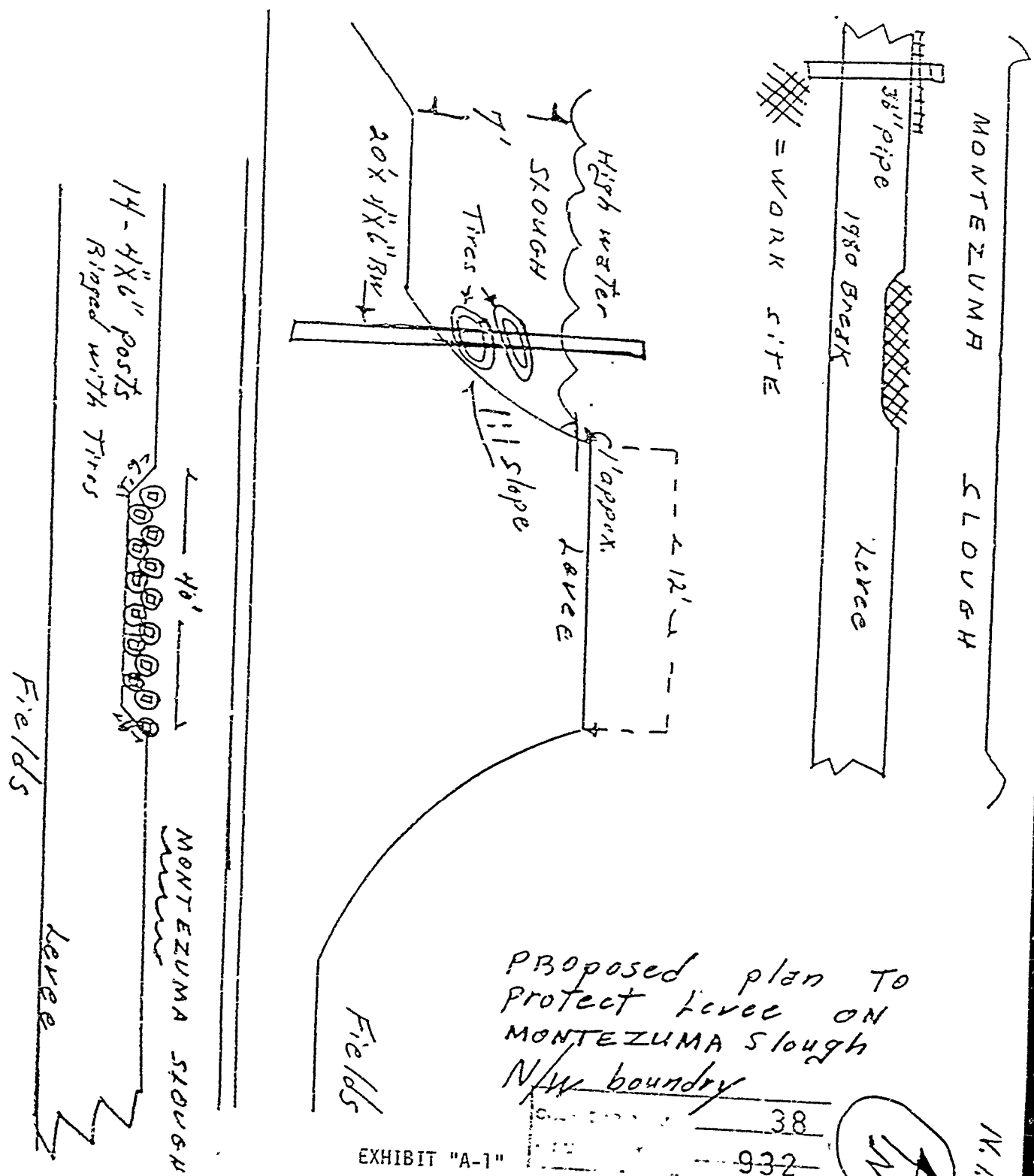

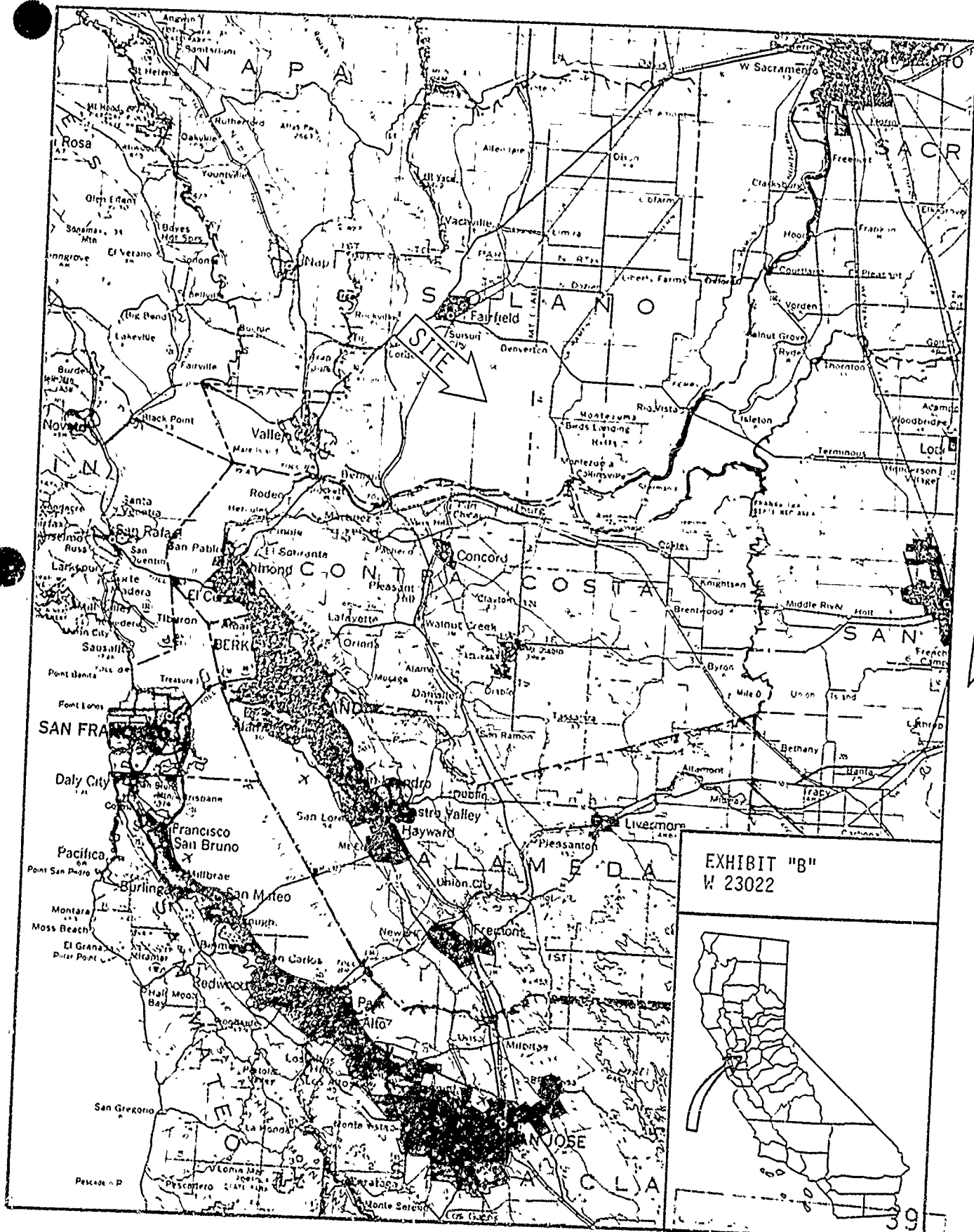
