GENERAL PERMIT - PUBLIC AGENCY USE

APPLICANT: State of California  
Department of Fish and Game  
350 Golden Shore Drive  
Long Beach, California 90802

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:  
A 0.019-acre parcel of submerged land,  
located in the Colorado River, Imperial  
County.

LAND USE: Placement and maintenance of 50 brush shelters  
and 11 spawning beds for fish habitat  
enhancement.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:  
Initial period: 49 years from April 1,  
1983.

CONSIDERATION: The public use and benefit, with the State  
reserving the right at any time to set  
a monetary rental if the Commission finds  
such action to be in the State's best interest.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION :  
Pursuant to 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2003.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$120.
2. This project is exempt from CEQA because it consists of wildlife preservation activity by a public agency where no construction is involved.

Authority: 2 Cal. Adm. Code, Div. 3, Section 2905, Class 7.

3. Staff recommends waiving of the processing fee due to the fact that no impact will occur to State lands, and the project involves public trust of the State land.
4. The project is situated on lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6570.1, and is classified in a use category "B" which authorizes Limited Use. The project as proposed will not have a significant effect upon the identified environmental values.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. DETERMINE THAT AN ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENT HAS NOT BEEN PREPARED FOR THIS ACTIVITY AS SUCH DOCUMENT IS NOT REQUIRED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF P.R.C. 21084, 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15100 ET SEQ., AND 2 CAL. ADM. CODE 2905, AND FIND THAT THE PROJECT IS CONSISTENT WITH ITS USE CLASSIFICATION.
2. WAIVE THE PAYMENT OF PROCESSING FEES AS THIS PROJECT INVOLVES THE MANAGEMENT OF STATE LAND FOR THE ENHANCEMENT OF WILDLIFE, AND NO IMPACT WILL OCCUR TO THE LAND.
3. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME OF A 49-YEAR GENERAL PERMIT - PUBLIC AGENCY USE, FROM APRIL 1, 1983; IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC USE AND BENEFIT, WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT AT ANY TIME TO SET A MONETARY RENTAL IF THE COMMISSION FINDS SUCH ACTION TO BE IN THE STATE'S BEST INTEREST; FOR THE PLACEMENT OF 50 BRUSH SHELTERS AND 11 SPAWNING BEDS FOR FISH HABITAT ENHANCEMENT ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

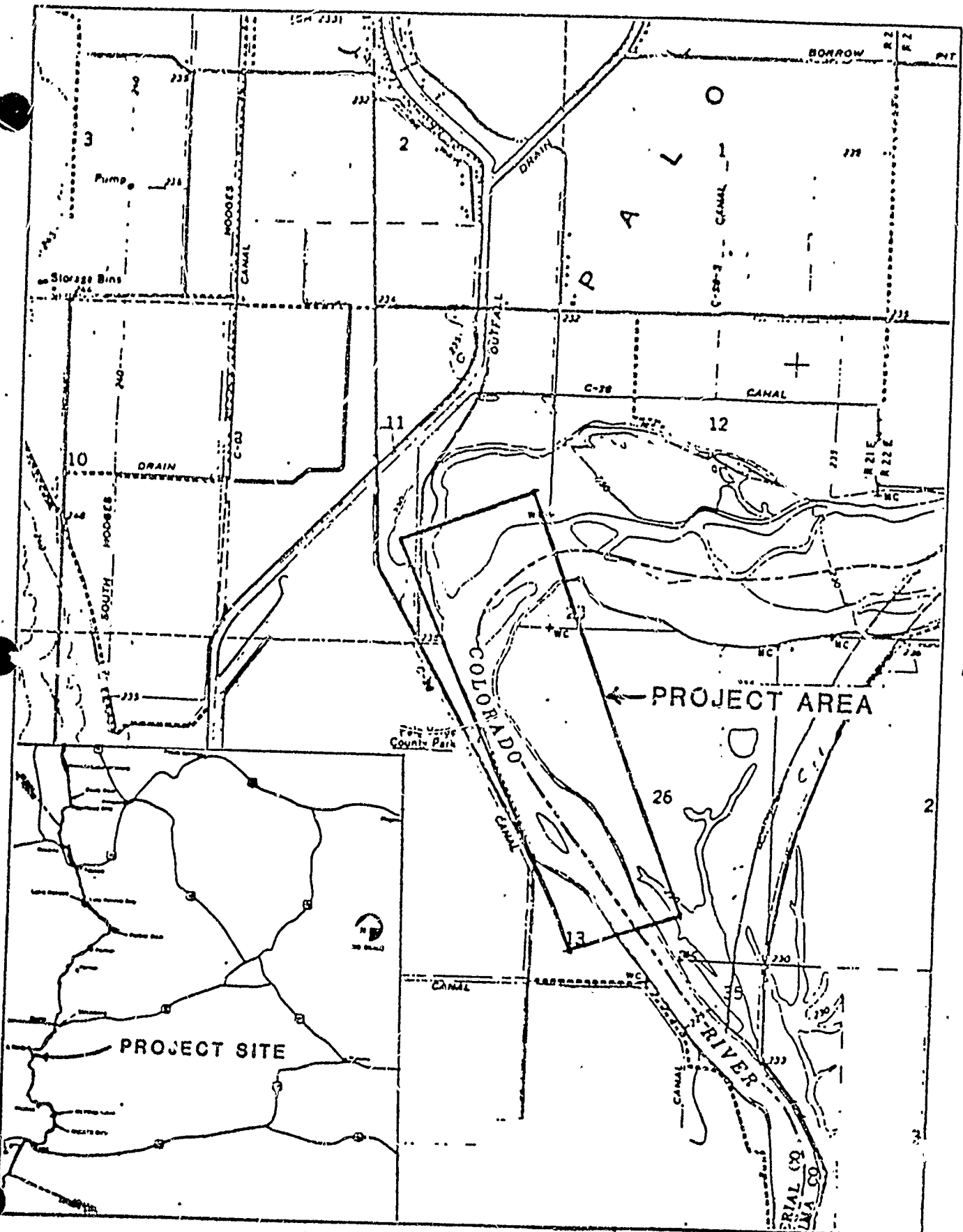


EXHIBIT A-1

## STRUCTURE LOCATIONS

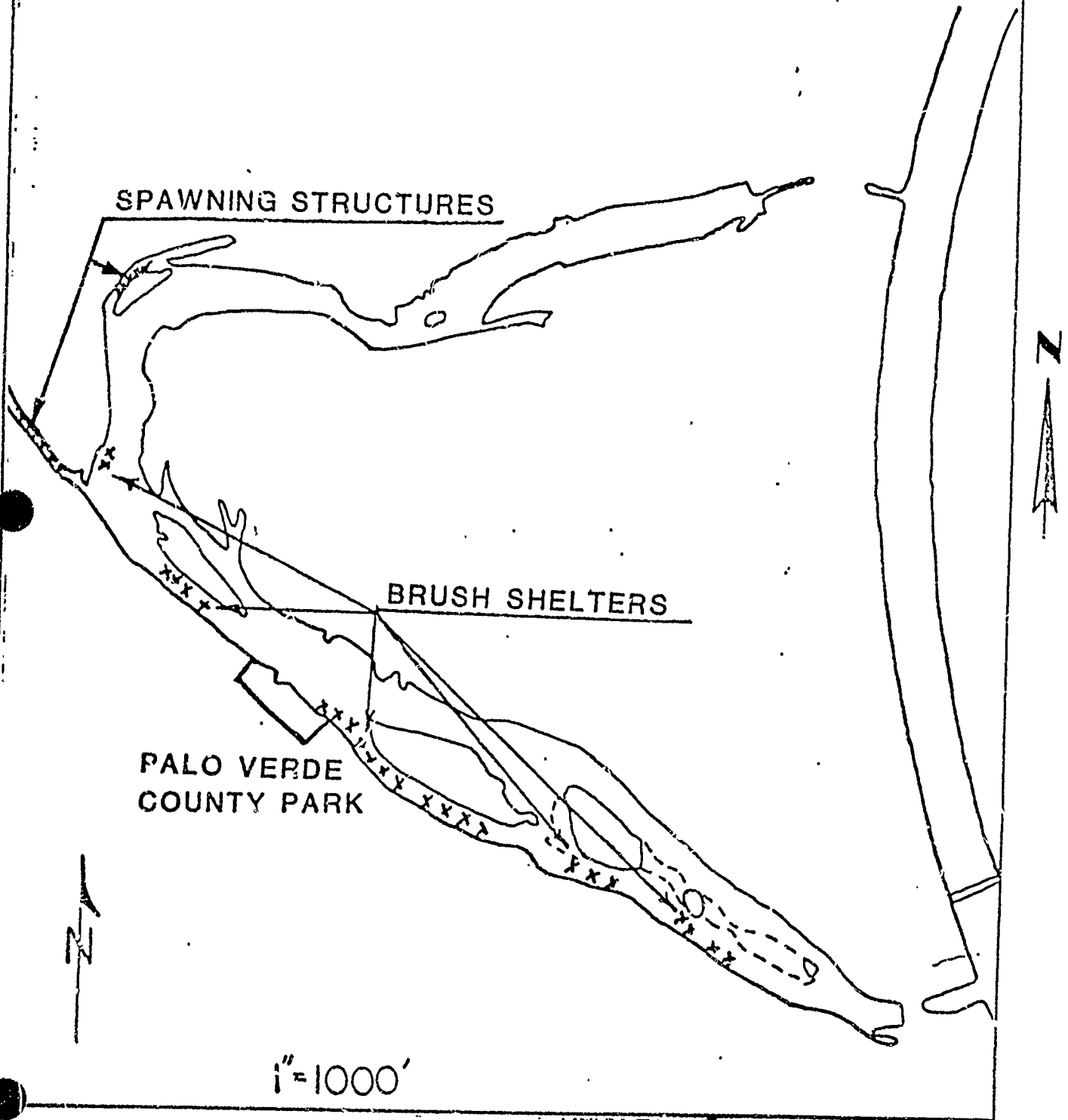

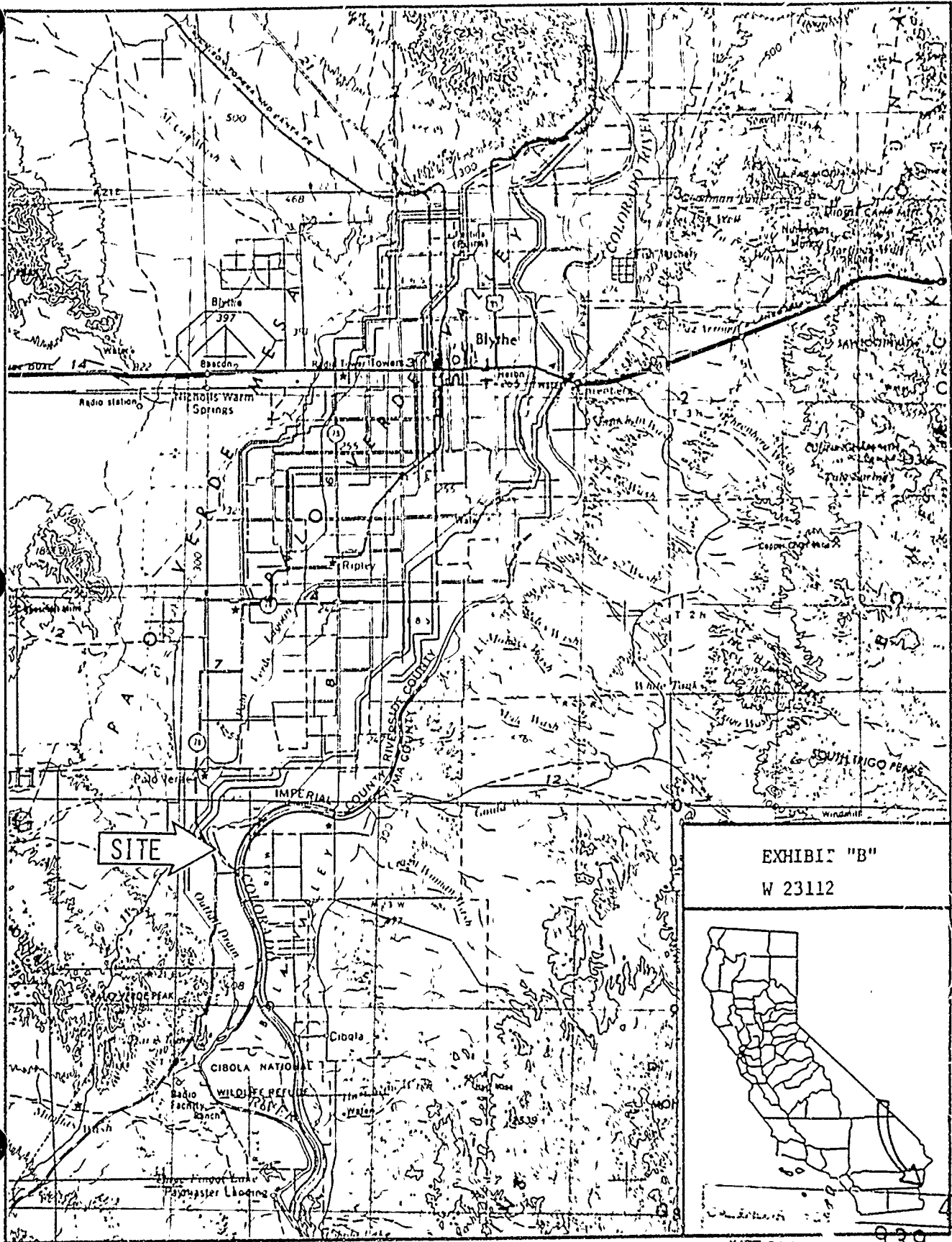
