TIMBER SALE AGREEMENT
IN GLENN COUNTY

In furtherance of the timber management program endorsed at the May, 1980 Commission meeting, the staff has prepared a harvest plan and solicited sealed bids for the sale of 362,000 board feet of commercial sawtimber within an 80-acre parcel of State school land, 35 airline miles west of Willows in Glenn County.

The sale was advertised in April in local and regional newspapers and bid packages sent to a mailing list of over 70 operations in Northern California. Two bids were received as shown on the attached Exhibit "C", as of May 3, the bid opening date, and the high bid was \$59,853.08 submitted by Louisiana Pacific Corporation. This is 37 percent above the appraised value determined by staff in March 1983.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. A Negative Declaration (No. 297) was prepared by Commission staff which was certified by the Commission at its February 1982 meeting. A Timber Harvest Plan has been filed with the California Department of Forestry.
2. This project is situated on State school lands not identified as possessing significant environmental values. A staff review of available information indicates no reason to identify the subject parcel as having such values at this time.

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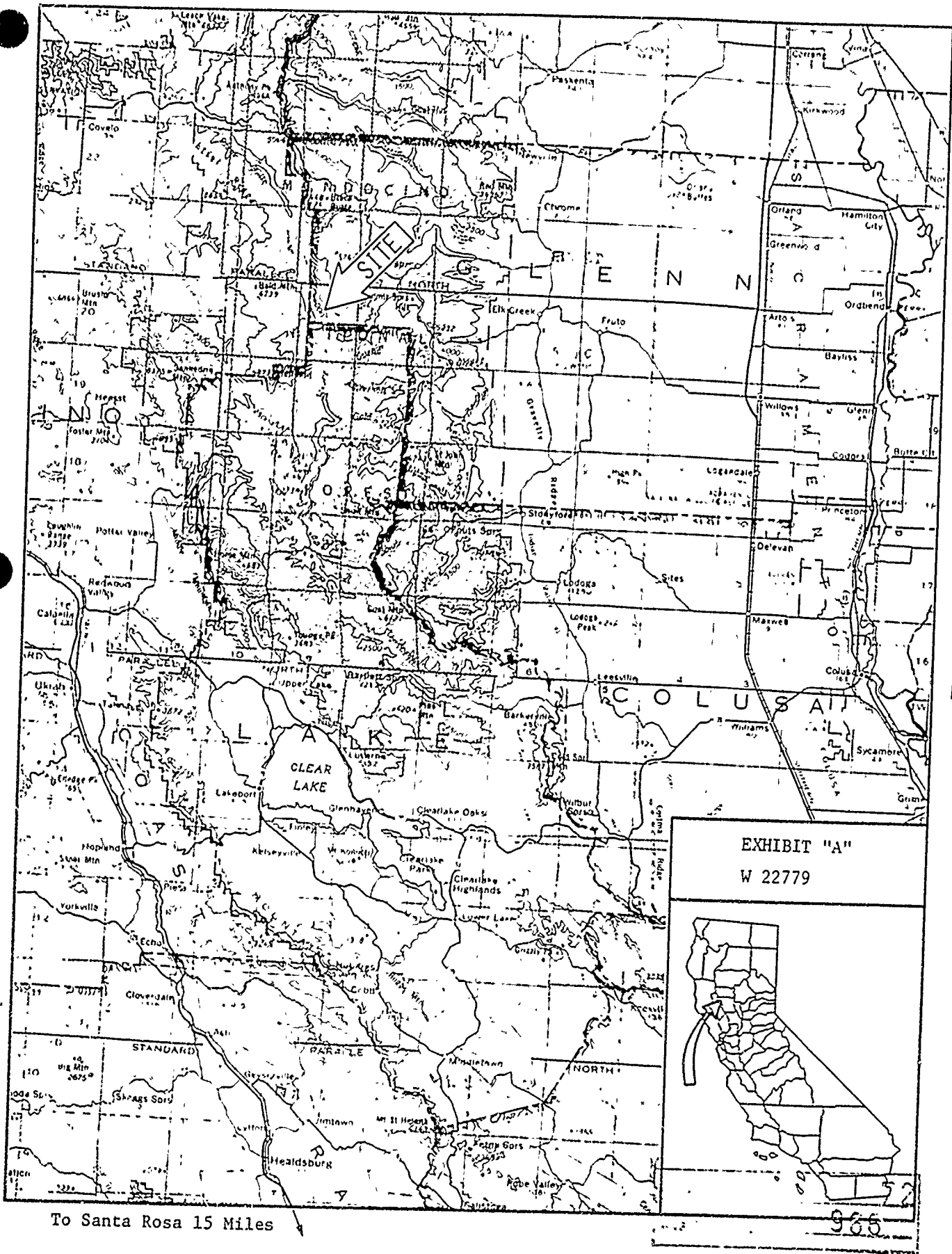


