## DREDGING PLRMIT

APPLICANT:

Southwest Marine Box 13308 San Diego, California 92113

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

State-owned submerged lands on the bed of San Diego Bay at the Southwest Marine Shipyard facility in the City of San Diego, San Diego County, California.

LAND USE:

Dredge a total of 410,000 cubic yards of material with 184,000 :ubic yards of material to be removed from lands under State jurisdiction to deepen the shipyard area to allow for deeper draft vessels and larger drydocks. Spoils are to be deposited at the E.P.A. authorized disposal site L.A. 5 located at 30° 36' 50" N and 117° 20' 40" W in the Pacific Ocean.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT: Initial Period:

One year from Commission action.

CERTIFY THAT AN EIR (SCH 82112405) FOR THIS PROJECT WAS PREPARED BY THE PORT OF SAN DIEGO AND CERTIFIED BY THE SAN DIEGO BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ON APRIL 19, 1983, IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF CEQA AND THAT THE COMMISSION HAS REVIEWED AND CONSIDERED THE INFORMATION CONTAINED THEREIN PRIOR TO APPROVAL OF THE PROJECT.
- 2. FIND THAT CHANGES OR ALTERATIONS HAVE BEEN REQUIRED IN OR INCORPORATED INTO THE PROPOSED PROJECT WHICH MITIGATE OR AVOID THE SIGNIFICANT ENVIRONMENTAL EFFECTS THEREOF AS IDENTIFIED IN THE COMPLETED EIR.

- AUTHORIZE THE STAFF OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION TO 4. ISSUE TO SOUTHWEST MARINE, THE DREDGING PERMIT ON FILE IN THE OFFICES OF THE COMMISSION; SAID PERMIT SHALL BE ISSUED IN CONSIDERATION OF A \$0.15 ROYALTY TO E' CHARGED PER CUBIC YARD FOR SPOILS PLACED IN THE E.P.A. APPROVED DISPOSAL S. L.A. 5 AND A \$0.25 PER CUBIC YARD ROYALTY FOR SPCILS PLACED ON PRIVATE PROPERTY OR SOLD FOR COMMERCIAL BENEFIT; SAID PERMIT SHALL BE FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR FROM DATE OF COMMISSION ACTION AND SHALL ALLOW THE DREDGING OF 184,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MINERALS, OTHER THAN OIL, GAS AND GEOTHERMAL FROM AN AREA OF SUBMERGED LANDS AT THE SOUTHWEST MARINE SHIPYARD IN SAN DIEGO BAY, SAN DIEGO COUNTY, CALIFORNIA; SAID AREA IS SHOWN IN EXHIBIT "A" AND "B" ATTACHED HERETO AND BY THIS REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF; THE MATERIAL DREDGED SHALL BE DEPOSITED IN A DISPOSAL SITE APPROVED BY ALL APPLICABLE REGULATORY AGENCIES. THE COMPLETE PERMIT IS CONTAINED IN FILE W 23134 LOCATED IN THE COMMISSION OFFICES.
