AUTHORIZATION FOR  
PREPARATION AND PROCESSING OF A  
STATE PATENT TO BE  
ISSUED TO C. V. GLEASON

Siskiyou County Title Company has requested that a State patent be issued for 160 acres, more or less, of State lieu lands in Siskiyou County. An application for purchase of the parcel (Shasta Land District 4236) was filed by C. V. Gleason with the Surveyor General on October 13, 1903 and a Certificate of Purchase 4741, showing payment made in full, was issued on April 6, 1904. The original certificate of purchase is in the files of the Commission and no patent has yet been issued to complete the chain of title on the parcel.

Staff has examined the file and other information submitted by Siskiyou County Title Company and has concluded that the laws relating to issuance of a patent for the above described lands have been complied with, and that the person to be named in the patent (C. V. Gleason) is entitled to it.
