- The salt water intake pipeline has been under lease from the State since February 15, 1952. The original lease was for a term of 11 years with two renewal options of ten years each, both of which were exercised. The prior rental was \$802.62 per annum.
- This project is exempt from CEQA because it is an existing facility pursuant to 2 Cal. Adm. Code, Section 2905, Class 1.
- 3. The project is situated on lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category "C" which authorizes Multiple Use. The project as proposed will not have a significant effect upon the identified environmental values.
