APPROVAL OF THE THIRD MODIFICATION OF THE 1983-84, PLAN OF DEVELOPMENT AND OPERATIONS AND BUDGET, LONG BEACH UNIT, WILMINGTON OIL FIELD, LOS ANGELES COUNTY

The City of Long Beach has requested approval of the Third Modification of the Plan of Development and Operations and Budget, Long Beach Unit, July 1, 1983 through June 30, 1984. This modification would revise the Procedures to correct oversights that now exist. The City has also requested that the Field Contractor be permitted to change certain account numbers used as references in the Budget.

The revisions of the Procedures provide for the inclusion of redrills with the new wells in the six month lists of approved wells to be drilled and the inclusion of redrills with new wells when approval is required for deviation from a designated bottom hole location. Also as revised in addition to the Executive Officer, the Chief, Fatractive Development Program, State Lands Commission would be authorized to approve Redrills and Permanent Abandonments. These revisions have been requested by the Commission Staff.
