AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

A strip of land five feet wide and 620 feet long (3,100 square feet or a 0.071-acre parcel, more or less) of State school land, located in Humboldt County.

LAND USE:

Installation, operation and maintenance of a 3/4 inch NSF approved plastic water pipeline. The pipeline will be buried.

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE:

Initial period:

Ten years from October 1, 1983.

Special:

Due to the minor nature of the improvement staff recommends that liability insurance not be required.

CONSIDERATION:

\$100 per annum, with the State reserving the right to fix a different rental on each fifth anniversary of the lease.
