AN APPLICATION TO PROSPECT FOR MINERALS
OTHER THAN OIL AND GAS AND GEOTHERMAL RESOURCES,
RIVERSIDE COUNTY

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

Approximately 160 acres of State school
land - N $\frac{1}{2}$ of N $\frac{1}{2}$, Section 16, T6S R13E,
SBM, Riverside County, 34 miles east of
Indio, one mile south of Interstate Highway
10 in the vicinity of the Hayfield Pumping
Station and Hayfield Dry Lake.

BACKGROUND:

On June 17, 1983, staff received a partially
complete application from Keister and Brandvig
for a prospecting permit for the subject
land parcel which was previously under
permit to Baby Comstock, Inc. The prior
permit had expired on May 31, 1983.

After initiating processing of the Keister
and Brandvig application, Staff learned
that on July 18, 1983, Baby Comstock, Inc.
filed a claim with the State Board of Control

for damages of over ten million dollars through alleged misrepresentation by the State Lands Commission. The alleged misrepresentation involves matters conducted under Baby Comstock's expired prospecting permit on the subject land.

Staff counsel and the office of the Attorney General have advised against further processing of an application for a prospecting permit on this particular school land parcel and further recommended denial of the application of Keister and Brandvig pending resolution of the claims and threats of litigation by Baby Comstock, Inc.

AB 884: N/A, application is incomplete.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

CEQA does not apply to projects denied by the Lead Agency. (PRC 21080(b)(5). Additionally, projects that are denied require no evaluation as to consistency with identified environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370 et seq.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. DETERMINE THAT PROJECT DENIAL REQUIRES NO ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS PURSUANT TO P.R.C. 6370 ET SEQ. AND P.R.C. 21000 ET SEQ.
2. DENY WITHOUT PREJUDICE THE APPLICATION OF MERRILL J. KEISTER AND CLIFFORD BRANDVIG FOR A PERMIT TO PROSPECT FOR ALL MINERALS, OTHER THAN OIL, GAS AND GEOTHERMAL RESOURCES ON THE N $\frac{1}{2}$ OF N $\frac{1}{2}$, SECTION 16, T6S R13E, SBM, RIVERSIDE COUNTY, CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY 160 ACRES, ON THE BASIS THAT ANY PROSPECTING ACTIVITY ON THIS PARCEL MAY BE PREJUDICIAL TO THE STATE'S DEFENSE AGAINST CLAIMS AND LAWSUITS BY A PRIOR PERMITTEE OF THIS SCHOOL LAND PARCEL.
3. DETERMINE THAT UPON RESOLUTION OF THE CLAIMS AND LAWSUITS MERRILL J. KEISTER AND CLIFFORD BRANDVIG WILL BE GIVEN PRIORITY IN APPLYING FOR A PROSPECTING PERMIT ON THIS SCHOOL LAND PARCEL SUBJECT TO ANY COURT DECISION TO THE CONTRARY OR TO ANY SETTLEMENT BETWEEN THE PARTIES.

Claimant was misrepresented to by the State Lands Commission as to the requirements for obtaining a preferential Mineral Extraction Lease. As a result of such misrepresentations, his application was denied by the Commission on 4/28/1983. The standard utilized by the Commission in denying claimant's application differed from that originally conveyed to claimant.
