NOTICE OF INTENT TO CONTRACT
FOR THE PREPARATION OF AN EIR/EIS
FOR A PROPOSED OIL AND GAS PIPELINE
BETWEEN TAFT, CALIFORNIA AND MIDLAND TEXAS

The State Lands Commission has received an application from the All American Pipeline Company to construct an oil and gas pipeline between Taft, California and Midland Texas. The project will cross several State and Federally owned parcels. A Memorandum of Understanding has been signed with the Bureau of Land Management whereby a joint EIR/EIS will be prepared for the project. State Lands Commission will serve as lead agency. A private consultant will be hired to prepare the required documentation. The applicant has agreed to reimburse the State for all consultant costs, staff time and expenses associated with the environmental review of this project.

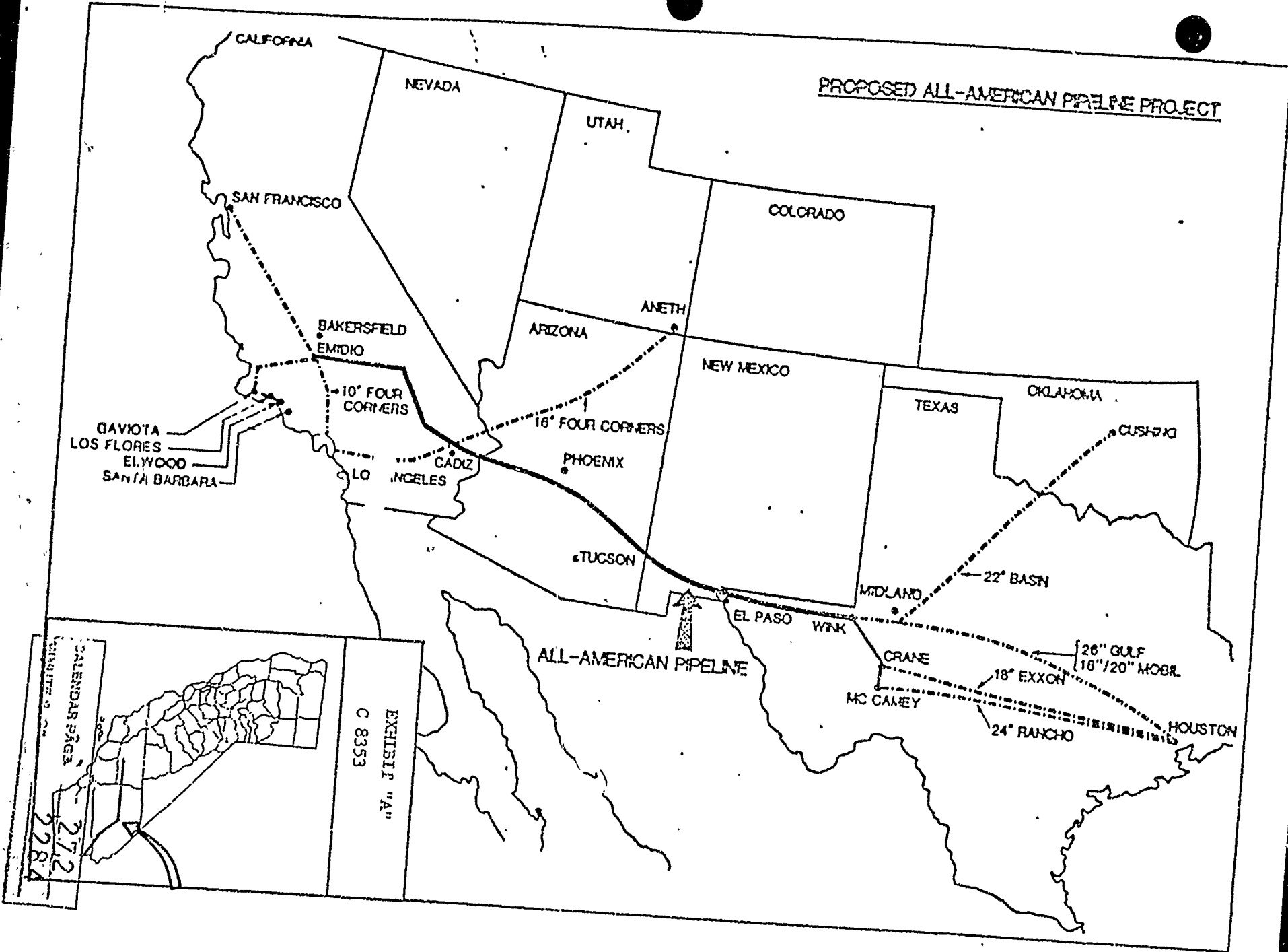
Pursuant to the delegation of authority of April 1978, for CEQA functions, staff will solicit Request for Proposals (RFP) for the preparation of environmental documents and the Executive Officer or her designee will execute an agreement with the lowest qualified proposer. An agreement will also be executed to formalize the terms and conditions of the reimbursement of costs by the applicant.
