On January 27, 1983, the State Lands Commission issued an industrial use lease to Exxon Company, I.S.A., for installation and maintensace of one mooring buoy ir the Santa Barbara Channel, Janta Barbara County. The Coastal Commission hearing ror a permit on the mooring buoy was held August 10,1983 . As a condition of the Coastal Commission permit, Exxon is required to change the location of the mooring buoy for safety purposes. The new location will minimize conflicts with commercial fishing operations, mariculture operations, other oil company operations, and damage to adjacent kelp beds. Exxon has submitted to staff a new location description for the buoy placement which has been approved by the Coastal Commission.
2. This activity is exempt from CEQA because it is not a project having a significant environmental effect pursuant to 14 Cal . Adm. Code, Div. E, Sec. $15061(\mathrm{t}-3)$.
3. The project is situated or lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1 anci is classifiec in a use category "B" which authnrizus Limited Use. The project as proposed will not have a significant effect upon the icentified environmental values.
