## OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- An EIR is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 14 Cal. Adm. Code, Div. 6, Section 15301(c) which exempts operation, repair, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing highways.
- 2. State land in the vicinity of this project is identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class "A", which authorizes Restricted Use. However, the right-of-way upon which this project is situated is excluded from this classification, and is considered to be unnominated.
- 3. In compliance with Section 6373 of the P.R.C., a General Plan has been prepared and filed with the Legislature.
- 4. A staff review shows that the land is not suitable for cultivation and therefore may be sold under the rules and regulations and at a price fixed by the Commission.

- FIND THAT A GENERAL PLAN FOR THE USE OF THE SUBJECT PROPERTY HAS BEEN PREPARED BY THE COMMISSION'S STAFF AND FILED WITH THE LEGISLATURE, PURSUANT TO P.R.C. 6373.

AUTHORIZE THE SALE, WITHOUT ADVERTISING, OF THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF, TO THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, SUBJECT TO ALL STATUTORY AND CONSTITUTIONAL RESERVATIONS INCLUDING ALL GEOTHERMAL AND MINERAL RESOURCES FOR \$6,700 CASH.

A strip of land in San Bernardino County, California, in Section 36, T1N, R11E, SBM, said strip of land being 100 feet wide, the centerline of which is described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the West line of said section, distant along said West line, N 7° 13′ 01″ W 199.80 feet from a brass disk marking the Southwest corner of said section, thence N 88° 15′ 28″ E 593.84 feet; thence N 88° 27′ 05″ E 2382.28 feet; thence N 88° 40′ 50″ E 1805.96 feet to the beginning of a tangent curve to the right having a radius of 3000 feet; thence Easterly along said curve, through an angle of 8° 30′ 27″, a distance of 445.44 feet; thence S 82° 48′ 44″ E 88.11 feet to a point on the East line of said section, distant along said East line N 1° 19′ 57″ W 222.99 feet from a brass disk marking the Southeast corner of said section.

GENERAL PIAN

The State of California, Department of Transportation has applied to the State Lands Commission to purchase 12.20 acres of state school land in Section 36, Township 1 north, Range 11 east, San Bernardino Base and Meridian.

The subject property is a strip of land, 100 feet wide and 5,314 feet long, underlying Route 62, approximately 14 miles east of Twentynine Palms in San Bernardino County. The existing highway traversing this parcel was recently entered into the State Highway System; however, there is no record that the right-of-way was ever conveyed for highway purposes.

This General Plan is submitted to the Legislature in accordance with Section 6373 of the Public Resources Code.
