AUTHORIZATION FOR PREPARATION AND  
PROCESSING OF A STATE PATENT  
TO BE ISSUED TO JOSEPH ALEXANDER

Founders Title Company has requested that a State patent be issued for 29.37 acres, more or less, of State lieu lands in Sonoma County. An application for purchase of the parcel (San Francisco Land District 15135) was filed by Joseph Alexander with the Surveyor General on July 18, 1911 and a Certificate of Purchase 206, showing payment made in full, was issued on November 10, 1911. The original certificate of purchase is beyond the control of the present owner of the land and an affidavit pursuant to P.R.C. 7729 has been provided. No patent has yet been issued to complete the chain of title on the parcel.

Staff has examined the file and other information submitted by Founders Title Company and has concluded that the laws relating to issuance of a patent for the described lands have been complied with, and that the person to be named in the patent (Joseph Alexander) is entitled to it.

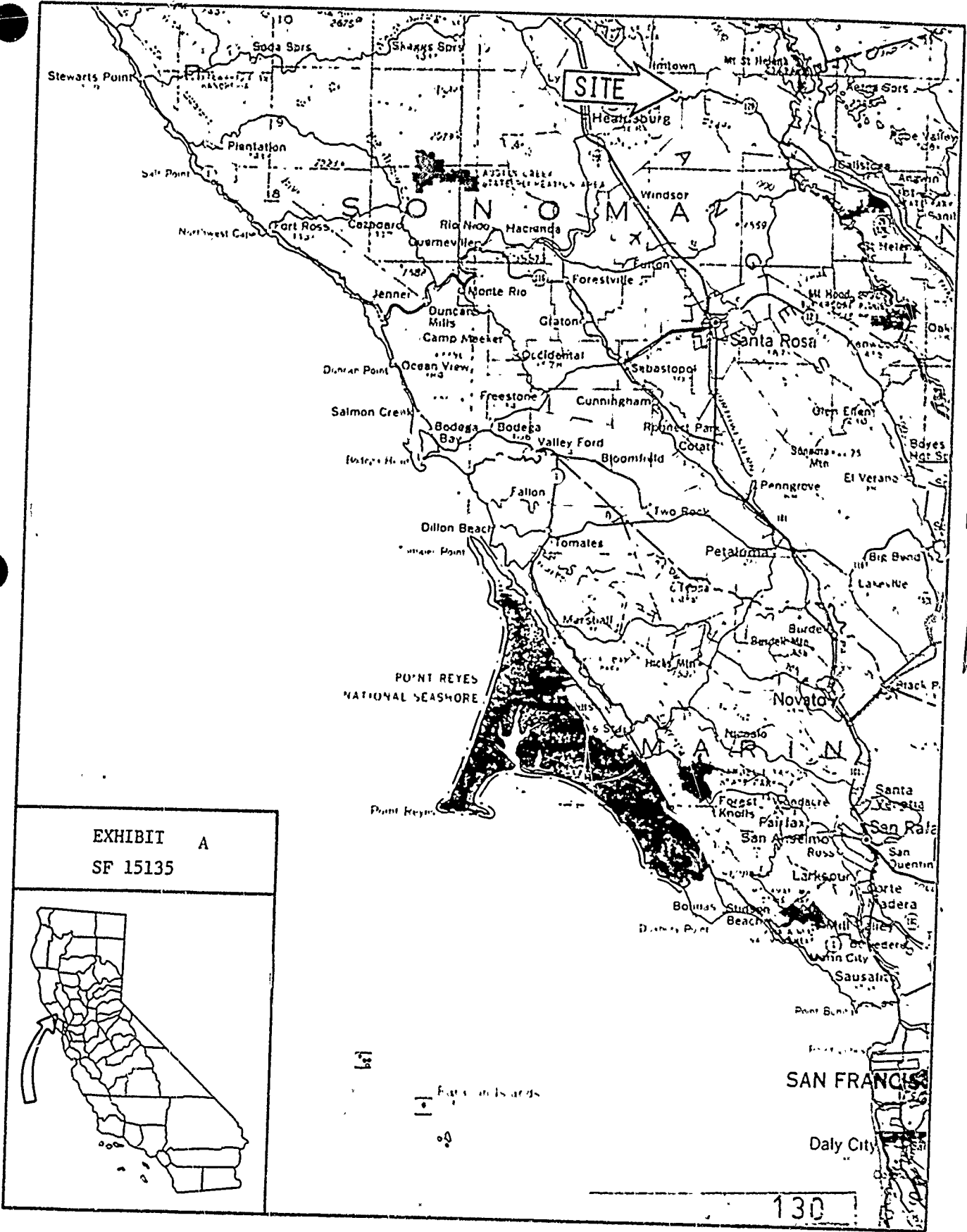
