APPROVAL OF
LITIGATION AND TITLE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN CASIMER AND ETTA MALINOWSKI.
v. STATE LANDS COMMISSION

BACKGROUND: The Malinowski's are owners of a portion Of an island located in the Sacramento River, Sacramento County, commonly known as Long Island. A isspute over the location of the boundary between the Malinowski's upland and the State's sovereign land arose when the Malinowski's began the process of subdividing this upland parcel. The State felt that a portion of the area being subdivided was sovereign land based on a stipulated judgment entered in 1948 in the case of Rosillini, et al. v. State. The State felt the boundary line established by this judgment was a fixed line. The Malinowski's felt that the judgement established a meander line and therefore the true boundary of their upland parcel was the current high water mark.

In May 1977 the Malinowsli's filed a suit to quiet title against the State and were successful in that the court cistermined that the 1048 judgment line was a moving line. The State then filed an appeal of that judgment.

CURRENT SITUATION:
Staff of the fommission and the Attorney General's Offic: have been negotiating a settlement of this litigation with the Malinowski's. A.itigition and Title Settlement Agreement has been negotiated and is on file in the Sacramento Office of the Commission. The basic terms of the agreement are:

1. A Boundary Line Agreement will be executed between the Malinowski's and the State establishing the current Mean High Tide Lirie, described in attached Exhibit "A" as fixed boundary.
2. The Malinowski's will pay $\$ 18,000$ to the Land Bank in exchange for any interest of the state between the new boundary described in Exhibit "A" attached and the boundary described in the 1948 Rosillini juagment.

Staff of the Commission and that of the Attorney General's Office believes that approval of the proposed settlement agreement as on file will be in the best interest of the State.

## IT IS THEREFORE RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. FIND THAT THIS ACTION IS IN SETTLEMENT OF A TITLE DISPUTE AND IS IN LIEU OF LITIGATION; THLREFORE, CEQA DOES NOT APPLY.

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2. DETERMINE AND DECLARE THAT THE SUBJECT COMPROMISE TITLE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT IS IN THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE state and that tye settlevent parcel has been exiluded FROM THE PUBLIC CHANNELS AND IS NO LONGER AVAILABLE OR USEFUL OR SUSCEFTIBLE OF BEING USED FOR COMMERCE, NAVIGATION AND FISHING, IS NO LONGER, IN FACT, TIDELANDS OR SUBMERGED LANDS AND UPON RECORDATION OF THE COMPROMISE title settlement agreenent shall be free from the public TRUST FOR COMMERCE, NAVIGATION AND FISHERIES.
3. DECLARE AND DETERMINE THA THE SUM OF $\$ 18,000$ THE STATE IS RECEIVING PURSUANT TO THE SUBJECT COMPROMISE TITLE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT IS EQUAL TO OR GREATER THAN THE value of the state's interest being given up im the SETTLEMENT PARCEL.
4. DETERMINE AND DECLARE T'tAT THE SUBJECT COMPROMISE TITLE SETTLEMENT IS BEING MADE IN LIEU OF LITIGATION, IS A TITLE SETTLEMENT WITHIN THE MEANING OF PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE SECTION 8601(d) AND AUTHORIZE ACCEPTANCE OF THE SUM OF $\$ 18,000$ TO BE DEPOSITED IN THE LAND BANK FUND PURSUANT TO PUBLI RESOURCES CODE SECTION 8625(a).
5. APPROVE THE PFOPOSED COMPROMISE TITLE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENİ In Substantially the form on file in the sacramento OFFICE OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION, BETWEEN THE STATE AND THE MALINOWSKI'S.
6. AUTHORIZE EXECUTION, ACCEPTANCE AND RECORDATION OF THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT TOGETHER WITH ANY OTHER DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO ESTABLISH AS A FIXED BOUNDARY THAT LINE described in exhibit "a" attached hereto.
7. AUTHORIZE THE STAFF OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSIO'I AND THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL TO TAKE ALL FJRTHER STEPS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, appearances in any legal proceedings to finalize the SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT.
