## OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. On June 23, 1983 the State Lands Commission approved Lease PRC 6444.1 for the use of State land underlying the Fourth of July Yacht Club's recreational facilities. The lease required liability insurance coverage for all watercraft.

The Lessee has requested an amendment to the lease to provide that the liability insurance coverage requirement for watercraft only applies to watercraft 26 feet and under.

The authorized improvements include three dinghy stringlines, one swim float, pier, ramp, and three additional floats. The staff has been informed that there is little exposure to watercraft larger than 26 feet due to limitations of the facility. The amendment will limit watercraft within the lease premises to that which is not over 26 feet in length.

- 2. The effective date of the proposed amendment is October 1, 1983.
- 3. This activity is exempt from CEOA as it is not considered to be a project pursuant to P.R.C. 21065 and 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15378.
