## DREDGING PERMIT

APPLICANT:

Moss Landing Harbor District P. O. Box 102 Moss Landing, California 95039

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION: Granted lands on the bed of Moss Landing Harbor, Monterey County, California.

LAND USE:

Dredge up to 40,000 cubic yards of sediments to deepen the harbor channel for safe navigation and mooring within the harbor.

Spoils to be deposited at authorized sites on an adjacent harbor district-owned beach and at United States Army Corps of Engineers approved disposal site S.F. 12 off Sandholdt Pier. No royalty will be charged for spoils placed on publicly owned lands. A royalty of \$0.25 per cubic yard will be charged for spoils placed on privately owned property or sold for commercial benefit.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT: Initial Period: One year from December 1, 1983.

CONSIDERATION: No royalty to be charged for spoils placed on publicly owned lands and beaches. A royalty of \$0.25 per cubic yard will be charged for spoils placed on private property or sold for commercial benefit.
