OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

In June 1982, the Coastal Commission 1. issued a permit to the Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR) to operate an Off-Highway-Vehicle Area on Pismo Beach north of Oso Flaco Creek in San Luis Chispo County. As a condition of the permit, DPR was required to erect an east/west aligned vehicle barrier north of Oso Flaco Creek running seaward to the mean low water line. The purpose of the barr er was to prohibit vehicle access to the dune area south of Oso Flaco Creek and thereby serve to protect the dunes, archaeological resources, and the wet environments of the area. Pedestrian traffic is not impeded by the vehicle barrier. The vehicle barrier was to be erected prior to August 31, 1983 and this construction has been accomplished.

In July 1983, staff notified DPR that a permit would be required for that portion of the vehicle barrier which crosses over State property.

- 2. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$100.
- This project is exempt from CEQA because it involves existing facilities pursuant to 2 Cal. Adm. Code, Sec. 2905, Class 1.
- 4. The project is situated on lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1 and is classified in a use category "B" which authorizes Limited Use. The project as proposed will not have a significant effect upon the identified environmental values.
