Code 15061), the staff has determined that these activities are exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as categorical exempt projects. These projects are exempt under Class 1 (existing facilities. Item No. 1), and Class 2 (Recon of damaged facility, Item No. 2 Cal Adm. Code 2905.

Authority: P.R.C. 21084. 14 Cal Adm. Code 15300, and 2 Cal Adm. Code 2905.

- 2. These activities involve lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370 et .eq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the projects as proposed are consistent with the lands' use classification.
- 3. Affects Item No. 1: General
 Permit-Recreational Use No. FRC 5377.1
 was approved by the Commission in
 August 1977, but was never issued.
 In 1978 all such General Permits qualified
 for rent-free status, and the applicant
 did not respond to staff's correspondence.
 The upland property has subsequently
 been sold twice, and the latest owner
 of record is now applying for a permit
 under the rent-free status.
