ANNEXATION OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS, CITY OF CARLSBAD, SAN DIEGO COUNTY

The State Lands Commission has received a request from San Diego County LAFCO to review and approve the annexation and boundaries of the proposed Batiquitos Pointe Reorganization annexation.

This area includes approximately 50.53, more or less, acres of land including a portion of the present and historic tide and submerged lands in the bed of Batiquitos Lagoon. The area proposed for annexation is 'ocated between previously annexed areas east of the Santa Fe Railroad right-of-way and west of and including former US Highway 101.

Pursuant to Government Code Section 35009, the Commission is to review and approve or deny the proposed annexation boundaries as appropriate and correct.

The staff of the Commission has reviewed the proposed annexation boundary description and finds it adequate. Furthermore, staff has no objection to transfer of local police power jurisdiction from the county to the city and, therefore, submits the recommendations of approval below.

- 7. thence northwesterly along said city boundary and mean high tide line to an intersection with the southwesterly extension of the southerly lot line of Lot 6 of said Section 3. shown on Record of survey Map No. 6561, filed in the County Recorder's Office of said County, being also an angle point in the boundary of the City of Carlsbad as established by their Ordinance No. 1141, adopted December 7, 1971, by said City;

North 60° 21' 05" East, 204.96 feet along said southwesterly extension and southerly lot line to an intersection with the westerly line of said State Highway, as described in deeds to the State of California, recorded July 23, 1926, in Book 1258, page 1 of Deeds, Records of saic County and April 9, 1935, in Book 393, page 200 and April 9, 1935, in Book 358, page 451 of Official Records of said County;
 - B. North 60° 21' (" East, 270.03 feet to a point in the nortneasterly line or said State Highway as described as Parcel No. 2851 in deed from John M. Metcalf, et al., to the State of California, recorded on June 23, 1954, in Book 5130, page 473, of Official Records of said County;
 - C. North 17° 31 West, 823.25 feet along said northeasterly line to an angle point in the boundary of the City of Carlsbad as established by said Ordinance No. 1084;
- thence generally northwesterly, northerly, westerly and northwesterly along said northeasterly line and city boundary to the southerly line of County Road Suvey No. 339 (Ponto Drive) map on file in the County Engineers Office of said County;
- 10. thence South 89° 49' East along the southerly line of said Road Survey No. 339 to the Easterly line of the ABANDONED portion of the Atchison Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company's right-of-way across the said south two-thirds of said Lot 4, as shown on Record of Survey Map No. 682 filed in the Recorder's Office of said County;
