#### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. The Commission as Minute Item 14, at its March 23, 1982 meeting approved a Right-of-Way Lease for use of a 0.528 acre parcel to construct intake and outfall water pipelines to support an unshore fish farm facility. That lease was issued on April 19, 1982. Later, per Calendar Item 7 on February 28, 1983, the Commission extended the construction limiting date to March 31, 1986. The lessee wishes to retain that lease for the future permanent construction of the pipelines.

Because the Fish Farm project has been scaled down for the present time to a pilot project, the applicant plans to place (2) 36 inch suction lines 800 feet east of the current lease area which lead to a portable pump located on the upland. Waterward, the lines terminate at a pair of specially designed intake screens, approved by Department of Fish and Game, and are supported by flotation buoys, which are anchored in place.

- 2. A Negative Declaration was prepared and adopted for this project by Sonoma County Planning Department. The State Lands Commission's staff has reviewed such document and believes that it complies with the requirements of the CEQA.
- 3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.k.C. 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

- 4. FIND THAT THIS ACTIVITY IS CONSISTENT WITH THE USE CLASSIFICATION DESIGNATED FOR THE LAND PURSUANT TO P.R.C. 6370, ET SEQ.


