Authority: PRC 21084 and 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15300.

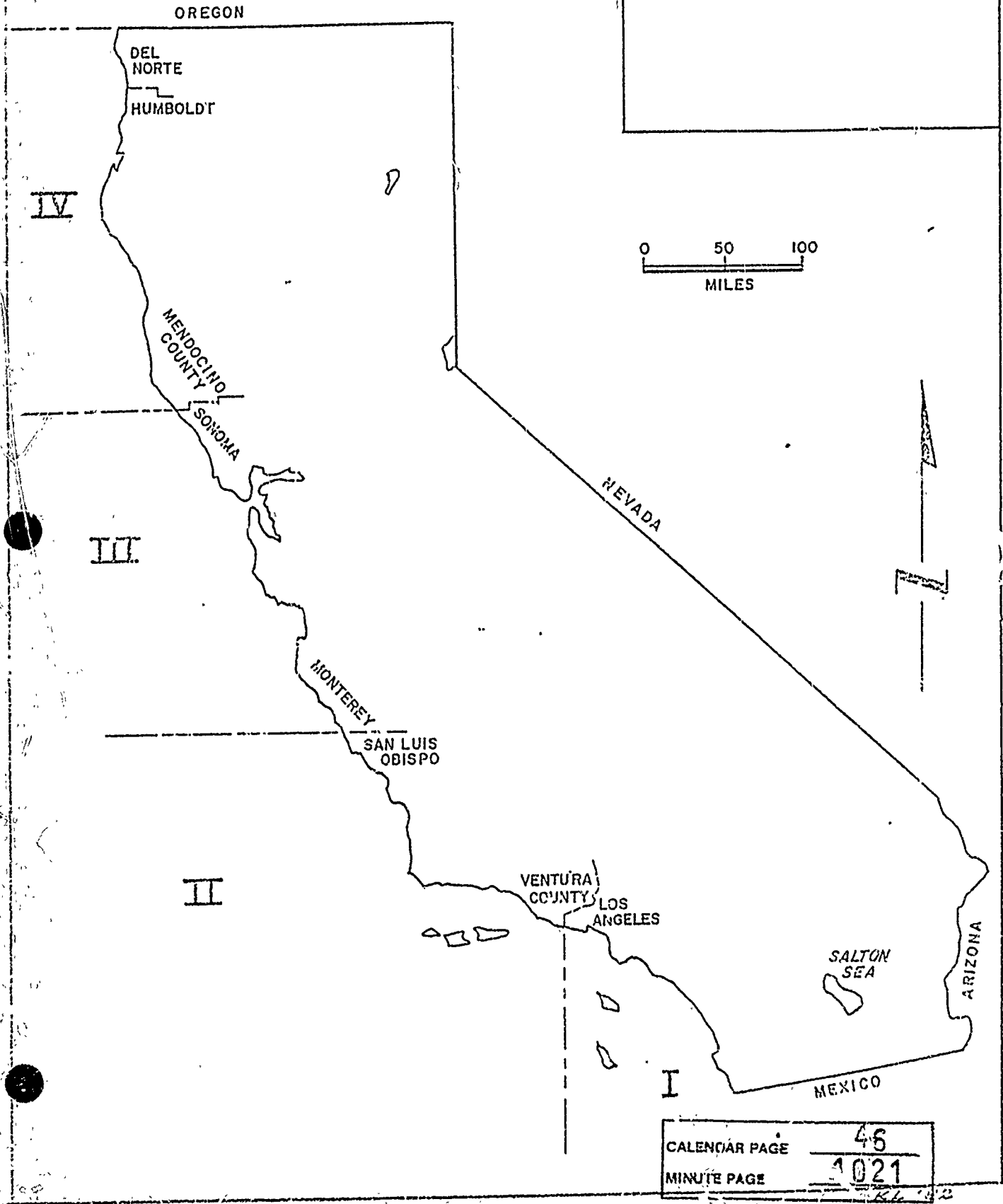
EXHIBIT: A. Map of four permit regions.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. FIND THAT THE ACTIVITY IS EXEMPT FROM REQUIREMENTS OF THE CEQA PURSUANT TO 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15061(b)(2) AND 15306, AND A CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT PROJECT (INFORMATION COLLECTION).
2. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO CHEVRON USA, INC., NON-EXCLUSIVE GENERAL PERMITS TO CONDUCT GEOLOGICAL SURVEYS FOR A TERM OF THREE (3) YEARS.
