TIMBER SALE AGREEMENT
IN LAKE COUNTY

In furtherance of the timber management program endorsed at the May, 1980 Commission meeting, the staff has prepared a harvest plan and solicited sealed bids for the sale of 202,000 board feet of commercial sawtimber within a 20-acre portion of State school land, six airline miles northeast of Upper Lake in Lake County.

The sale was advertised in April in local newspapers and notices sent to a mailing list of over 80 operators in Northern California. One bid was received as shown on the attached Exhibit "C", at \$12,978 submitted by Stenberg Enterprises. The bid was at the appraised value determined by staff in March 1984.

1. A Timber Harvesting Plan has been approved by the California Department of Forestry.
2. An environmental analysis document (Timber Harvest Plan) was prepared and certified for this project by the California Department of Forestry (CDF) under its certified program ((14 Cal. Adm. Code 15251(a))).

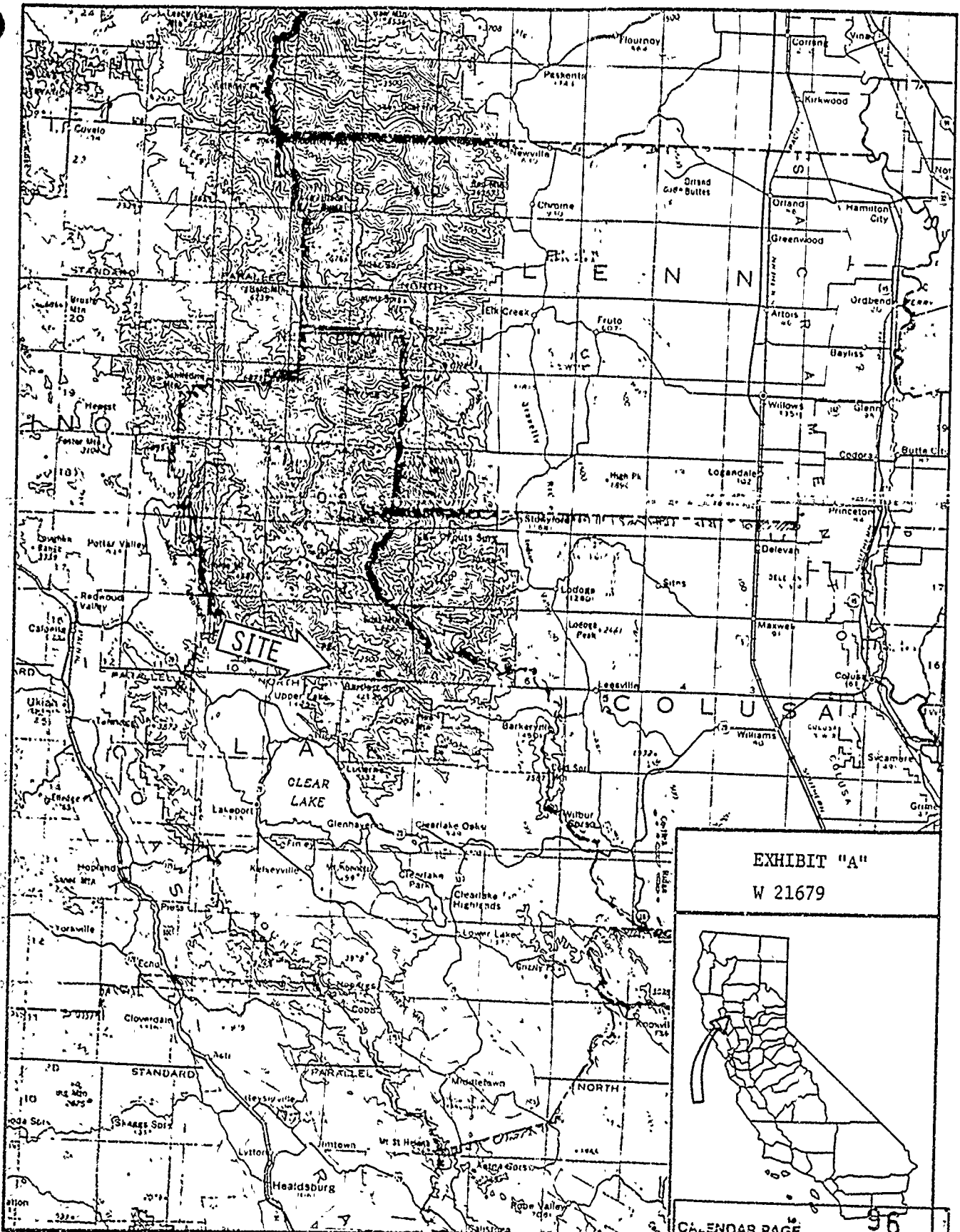

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. FIND THAT AN ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS DOCUMENT (TIMBER HARVEST PLAN) WAS PREPARED AND CERTIFIED FOR THIS PROJECT BY THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY UNDER ITS CERTIFIED PROGRAM (14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15251(a)), THAT THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION'S STAFF HAS REVIEWED SUCH DOCUMENT AND THAT THE CONDITIONS AS SPECIFIED IN 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15253(b) HAVE BEEN MET.
2. DETERMINE THAT THE PROJECT, AS APPROVED, WILL NOT HAVE A SIGNIFICANT EFFECT ON THE ENVIRONMENT.
3. ACCEPT THE BID IN THE AMOUNT OF \$32,978 AND AUTHORIZE ENTERING INTO A TIMBER SALE AGREEMENT WITH STENBERG ENTERPRISES FOR THE SALE OF 202,000 BOARD FEET OF SAWTIMBER IN N1/2 NW1/4 SECTION 36, T16N, R9W, MDM, LAKE COUNTY, UPON PAYMENT IN FULL OF THE TOTAL BID PRICE AND FURNISHING A PERFORMANCE BOND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,000.

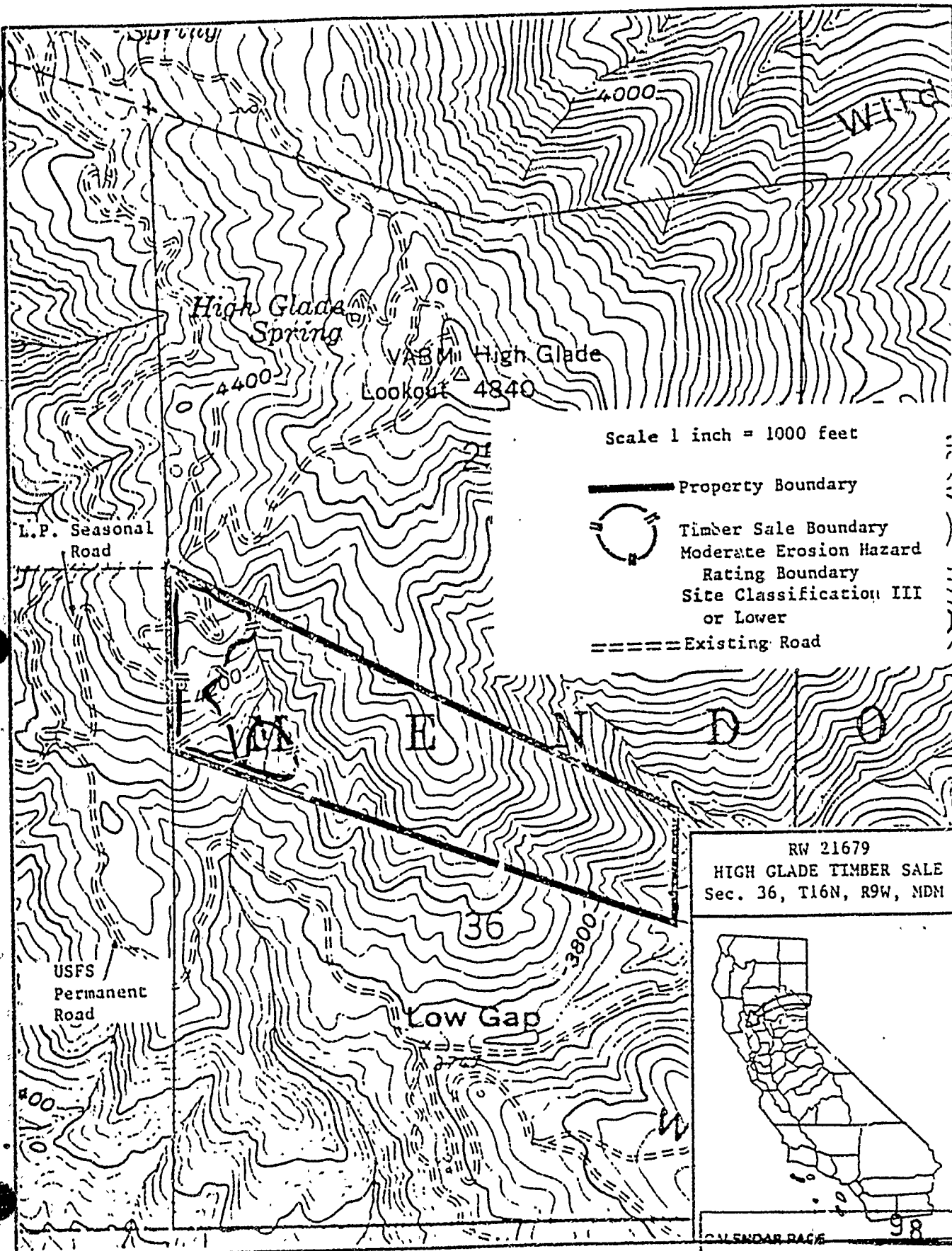
