DEFERMENT OF DRILLING OBLIGATION  
OIL AND GAS LEASE PRC 3314,  
SHELL WESTERN E&P INC., VENTURA COUNTY

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:  
State Oil and Gas Lease PRC 3314 issued to  
Shell Oil Company by the State Lands Commission  
on July 2, 1965, now held by Shell Western E&P  
Inc. (SWEPI), contains approximately  
5,430 acres of tide and submerged lands lying  
offshore the West Montalvo Oil Field, Ventura  
County.

PERTINENT INFORMATION:  
On April 29, 1981, Shell received authorization  
from the Commission to resume exploratory  
drilling operations on State Lease PRC 3314. In  
consideration of this approval, a Final EIR  
(EIR 281) was prepared that addressed the  
environmental effects of offshore exploratory  
drilling operations from a drilling vessel.

On April 22, 1982, the Commission certified a  
Negative Declaration and authorized the  
drilling of four other exploratory wells from  
an upland drillsite.

CALENDAR ITEM NO. 24 (CONT'D)

PRC 3314 lies east of a federal lease on which SWEPI has drilled four unsuccessful wells into a structure which extends into State lands. This geologic structure is more difficult to interpret as it trends east, and SWEPI is presently evaluating recently acquired seismic data which may improve interpretation of the structure.

Meanwhile, SWEPI has obtained all necessary permits to drill wells from an onshore drillsite to explore a near shore structure. Prior to drilling, however, SWEPI must clean up the drillsite area which is in a neglected condition.

SWEPI has requested a one year deferment during which to re-evaluate the lease geology and to clean up the onshore drillsite area.

Staff recommends that a six month deferment be granted.

1. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), staff has determined this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA because it is not a "project" as defined by CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.

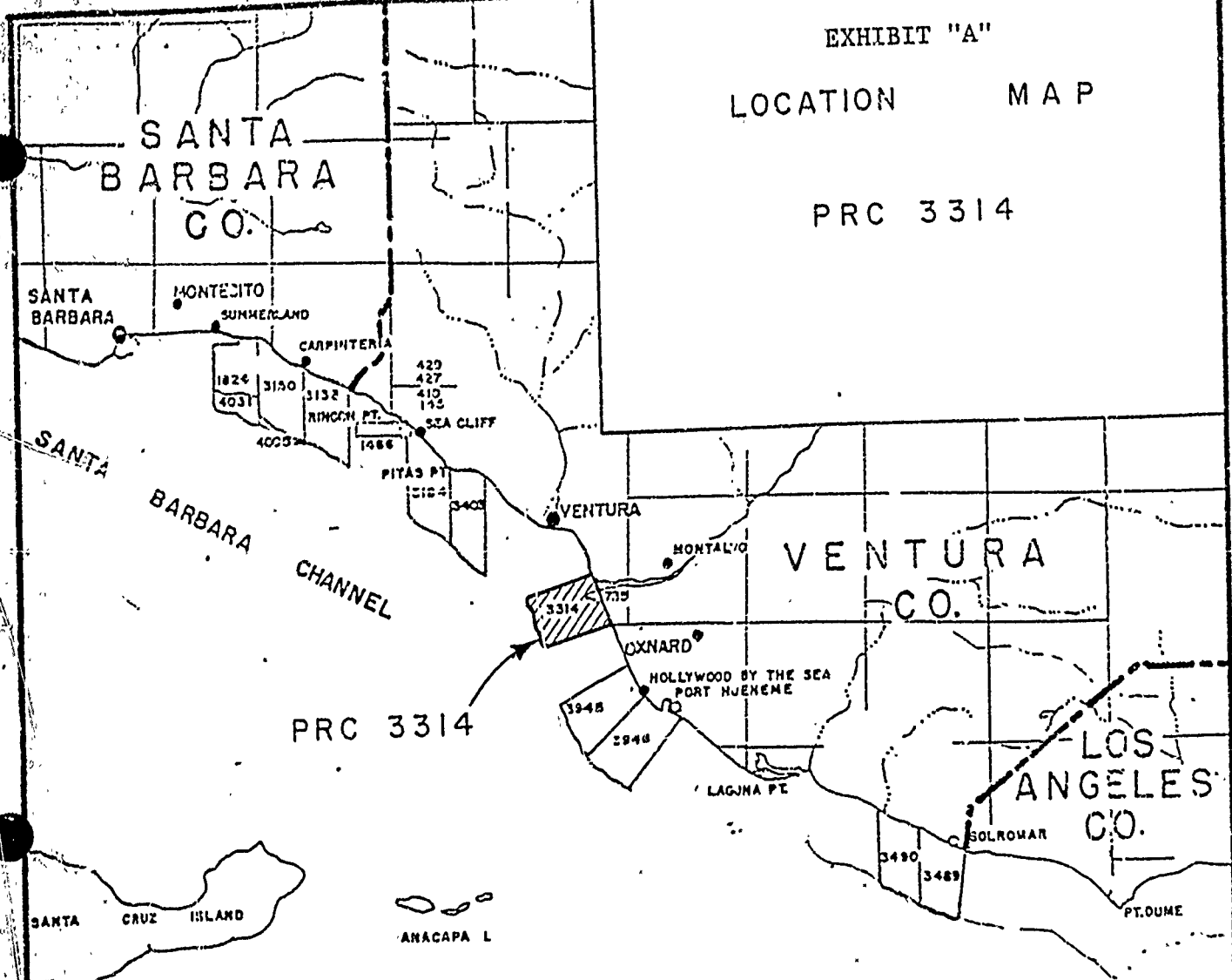

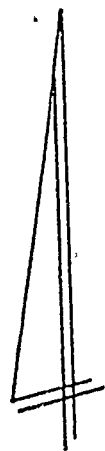
EXHIBIT "A"
