APPROVAL OF TERMINATION OF ORIGINAL LEASE PRC 2610.1 AND ISSUANCE OF A GENERAL LEASE -COMMERCIAL USE

APPLICANT: Sycamore Park, Inc. 601 Brannan Island Road Isleton, California 95641

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION: A 1.054 acre parcel of tide and submerged land in the Mokelumne River, Andrus Island, Sacramento County.

LAND USE: Commercial Marina.

TERMS OF ORIGINAL LEASE: Initial period:

: Fifteen years from October 1, 1976.

Renewal options: Three successive periods of ten years each.

Surety bond: \$2,000.

Public liability insurance: \$300,000 per occurrence for bodily injury and \$100,000 for property damage.

Consideration: \$450 per annum; five-year rent review.

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE:

1400 CA

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Thirty years from April 1, 1984.

Surety bond: \$5,000.

Initial period:

Public liability insurance: combined single limit coverage of \$1,000,000.

CONSIDERATION: \$1200 per annum; against 5% percent of gross income per annum, whichever is greater; with the State reserving the right to fix a different rental on each fifth anniversary of the Lease.

APPLICANT STATUS: Applicant is owner of upland.



## LAND DESCRIPTION

WP 2610

A parcel of tide and submerged land adjacent to the right bank of the Mokelumne River approximately three and one-half miles southeast of the City of Isleton, Sacramento County, California, said parcel being more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at a 1/2 inch pipe on Andrus Island from which USC&GS Triangulation Station "Jackson 1931" having California Coordinate System, Zone 3, coordinates of X = 1,677,269.16 and Y = 598,360.94 bears N 50° 24' 50" W, a distance of 13,981.40 feet; thence N 64° 45' 40" E, 12.20 feet to a point on the right bank of the Mokelumne River; thence along said bank N 20° 22' 30" W, 10.50 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence continuing along said bank N 20° 22' 30" W, 335.00 feet, thence into said river N 69° 37' 30" E, 137.00 feet; thence S 20° 22' 30" E, 335.00 feet; thence S 69° 37' 30" W, 137.00 feet to the point of beginning.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary high water mark.

The basis of bearings in this descript is True North.

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
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## NEGATIVE DECLARATION
