AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION: A 0.179-acru parcel of tide and submerged lands in the Petaluma River, Petaluma, Sonoma County.

LAND USE: Vessel moorage for off-loading fossilized oyster shells.

TERMS OF PROP.3ED LEASE: Initial period:

Ten (10) years from April 1, 1984.

Special: Lessee's insurance policies shall name State of California as additionally insured

CONSIDERATION: \$450 per annum; with the State reserving the right to fix a different rental on each fifth anniversary of the lease.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION: 1. The applicant desires to obtain a lease for an existing moorage site in the Petaluma River being utilized to off-load fossilized oyster shells to an upland processing plant. Farm products and redi-mix concrete are produced from the shells. The oyster shells are initially dredged from San Francisco Bay under State Lease PRC 5534.1 and barged to the off-loading site.

Special terms of the proposed lease are:


a. Volumetric rental shall not apply if the oyster shells are dredged by the lessee consistent with terms of PRC 5534.1.

b. The lessee shall name the State as additionally insured for liability insurance and provide a certificate of coverage to State Lands Commission.

c. The lessee must hold a valid upland lease authorizing use.

2. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
