OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. The applicant proposes to maintain the existing levee system protecting the Sacramento River in the stated reach. Maintenance of existing riprap and replanting of vegetation at selected sites will be done to maintain stabilization and protection. The work to be performed on this reach of the river was authorized by Congress in the Flood Control Act of 1917.
- Under terms of the permit, the permittee is required to notify State Lands Commission staff 60 days prior to commencing work at a given site with general plans and site description.
- Section 2 of the lease conforms to the Lyons/Fogerty decision.
- 4. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
- 5. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorical exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1 (Maintenance of Existing Structures) and 4(2)(Repair of Levec), 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905.
