- 1. The Stillwater Yacht Club has requested a lease from the State Lands Commission for the installation and operation of 23 mooring buoys and two floating wood platforms (10 x12') in Stillwater Cove. The buoys will be used on a seasonal basis from May 15 to October 31, in conjunction with the Club's sailing program.
- 2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorical exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 3, New Construction of Small Structures, 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905(c).

Authority: P.R C. 21084 and 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15300, and 14 Cal. Adm. Code 2905.

3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEOA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.


