1. Under the terms of the original 20-year lease issued in 1952 the Lessee had the right to renew said lease for additional periods of ten years and this right was exercised by the Lessee in 1972 for the first renewal.

2. Under a settlement agreement to Case No. 669-359 between the City and County of San Francisco, San Francisco Port Commission and Construction Aggregates Corporation, the State agreed to renew Mineral Extraction Lease PRC 709.1 in February 1982 for a single and final ten-year term to expire February 13, 1992.
3. On April 17, 1984, Construction Aggregates Corporation, the Lessee of PRC 709.1, submitted an application for State Lease Assignment Acceptance and approval for State Lease PRC 709.1. The proposed transfer of Lease PRC 709.1 is from Construction Aggregates Corporation (Assignor), to Construction Aggregates Corporation of California (Assignee).
4. Pursuant to the Commission's Delegation of Authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 California Administrative Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) because it is not a "Project" as defined by CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.

ASSIGNMENT OF LEASE

FOR VALUABLE CONSIDERATION, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned, CONSTRUCTION AGGREGATES CORPORATION, a Delaware corporation ("Assignor"), does hereby assign, transfer and set over unto CONSTRUCTION AGGREGATES CORPORATION OF CALIFORNIA, a Delaware corporation ("Assignee"), all of the Assignor's obligations, right, title and interest in, to and under that certain Lease Agreement dated as of February 14, 1952 by and between the State of California through the State Lands Commission (the "State") as the Lessor, and Assignor, as the Lessee, as amended and extended by a Lease Renewal and Amendment by and between the State and Assignor and dated March 17, 1982 (by the State) and dated February 22, 1982 (by Assignor). Such Lease, as amended and extended, will hereinafter be referred to as the "LEASE".

Assignor hereby represents and warrants to Assignee that it possesses good title to all of the right, title and interest of the Lessee under the LEASE and that Assignor has full power and authority to make this Assignment and conveyance.
