AUTHORIZATION FOR PREPARATION AND PROCESSING  
OF A STATE PATENT TO BE ISSUED TO  
DAVID G. WEBBER

Placer Title Company has requested a State patent be issued for 320 acres more or less, of State Seminary Land in Placer County. An application for purchase of the parcel (Marysville Land District 10) was filed by David G. Webber with the Surveyor General on November 30, 1858, and a Certificate of Purchase (Number 14), showing payment made in full was issued May 10, 1859. The original Certificate of Purchase is beyond the control of the present owner of the land and an affidavit pursuant to P.R.C. 7729 has been provided. No patent has yet been issued to complete the chain of title on the parcel.

Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as a statutory exempt project. The project is exempt as a ministerial project.

Authority: P.R.C. 21080 (b) (1), 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15268 (c), and 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2904.

Staff has examined the file and other information submitted by Placer Title Company and has concluded that the laws relating to issuance of a patent have been complied with, and that the person named in the patent (David G. Webber) is entitled to it.

2. FIND THAT THE LAWS IN RELATION TO THE ISSUANCE OF A STATE PATENT HAVE BEEN COMPLIED WITH, THAT PAYMENT IN FULL HAS BEEN MADE FOR SUCH PARCEL, AND THAT THE PERSON TO BE NAMED IN SUCH PATENT (DAVID G. WEBBER) IS ENTITLED TO IT.
3. GRANT STAFF AND THE OFFICE OF ATTORNEY GENERAL AUTHORITY TO PREPARE AND PROCESS A STATE PATENT TO BE ISSUED IN THE NAME OF DAVID G. WEBBER TO THE 320 ACRES, MORE OR LESS, OF STATE SEMINARY LANDS IN PLACER COUNTY, DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED HERETO.

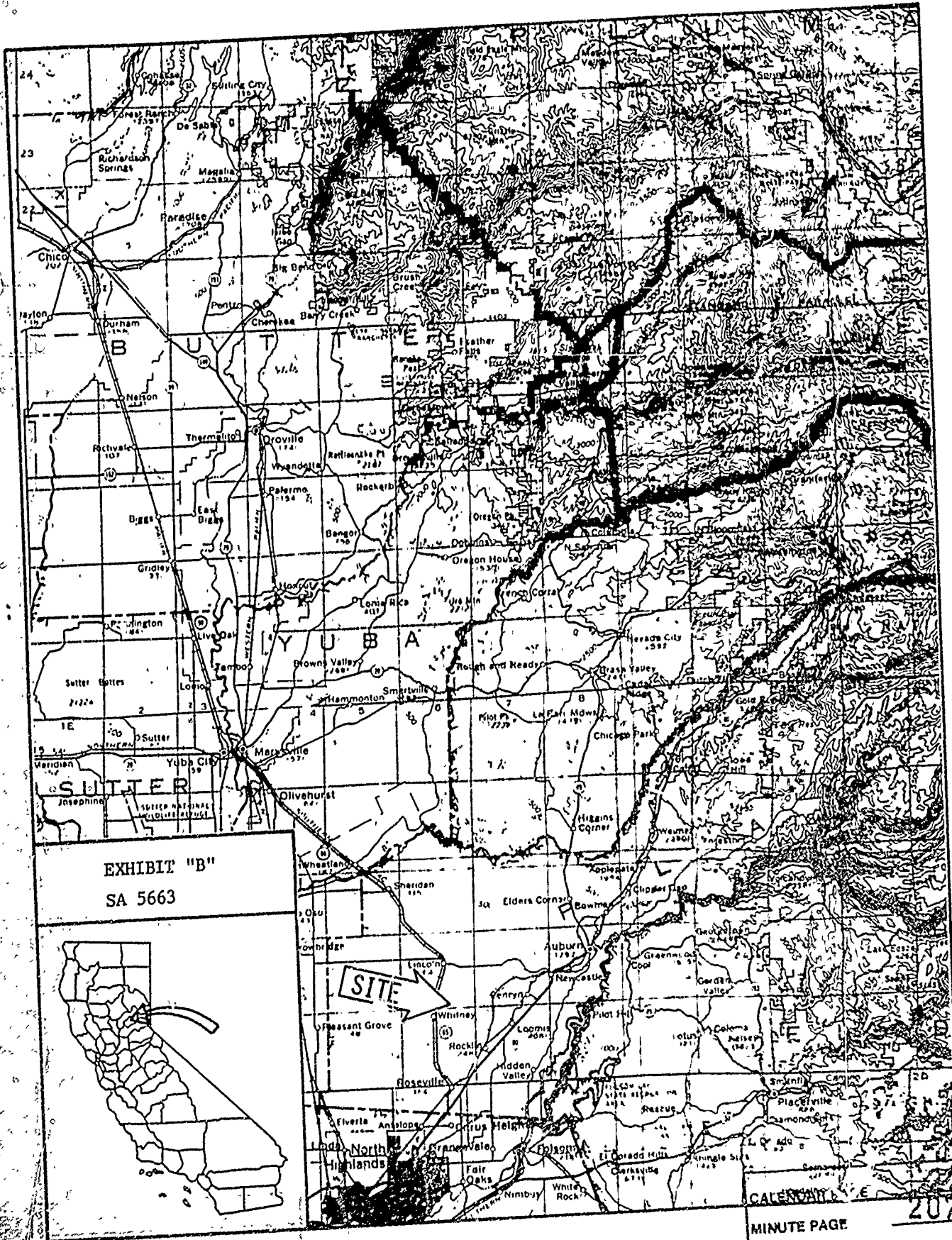
