RESCISSION OF COMMISSION APPROVAL OF GENERAL PERMIT - RECREATIONAL USE PRC 5355.1 TO LAKESHORE HOLDING COMPANY, LTD., AND ISSUANCE OF RECREATIONAL PIER PERMIT TO JOSEPH AND SANDRA KARP

APPLICANT:

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

A ,011-acre parcel and a 0.029-acre circular parcel of submerged land in Lake Tahoe, Placer County.

LAND USE:

Reconstruction and maintenance of an existing pier and maintenance of an existing buoy for private recreational boating.

BACKGROUND:

On June 21, 1984, Minute Item 7, the State Lands Commission authorized the issuance of a General Permit - Recreational use to Lakeshore Holding Company, Ltd. for the maintenance of an existing pier in Lake Tahoe, Placer County. Before the permit was signed on behalf of the Commission, the upland property reverted to the former owner by foreclosure procedure. This foreclosure document and other pertinent documents relating to the disposition of the upland property are on file in the office of the State Lands Commission and by reference made a part hereof. The upland property has now been sold to Joseph and Sandra Karp. Mr. and

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Mrs. Karp have made application to the Commission for a Recreational Pier Permit, together with the required fees. This permit will involve the reconstruction of the existing pier. The Karps qualify for a rent-free permit pursuant to Section 6503, 5 of the Public Resources Code.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:

Initial period:

Ten (10) years from June 21,

1984.

CONSIDERATION:

None. Rent-free pursuant to Section 6503.5 of the Public Resources Code.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061); Ethe staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) his a categorical exempt project. This project is exempt under Class 2 (replacement or reconstruction), 2 Cal. Adm: Code 2905/(6) and Class 1 (existing facilities), 2 Cal. Adm. 2905 (a) (2)

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This activity involves land identified as 02 possessing significant environmental values pursuant to PIR C. 6370; et seq Based upon the staff s consultation with the persons nominating such land and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff s opinion that the project as proposed is consistent with the land use classification.

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- The Commission at its meeting on November 27, 1978, suspended all leasing November 27, 1978, suspended all leasing for new construction at take Tahoe, except for mooring buoys in designated areas. This for mooring buoys in designated areas. This action was taken pending completion of an action was taken pending completion of an elike which addresses the cumulative impact of continued construction of piers in lake and continued use and reconstruction of an existing pier and maintenance of an existing pier and maintenance of an existing buoy in the lake, and therefore is not subject to the Commission's suspension of leasing activities for new construction.
- 4. This permit covering a structure in Lake Tahoe will include a condition subsequent that if any structure authorized is found to be in nonconformance with the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency's Shorezone ordinance and if any alterations, repairs, or removal required pursuant to said ordinance are not accomplished within the designated time period, then the permit will be automatically terminated, effective will be automatically terminated, effective lupon notice by the State and the site shall be cleared pursuant to the terms thereof.

### IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

- 4. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO JOSEPH AND SANDRA KARP OF A TEN-YEAR RECREATIONAL PIER PERMIT FROM JUNE 21, 1984, FOR RECONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF AN EXISTING PIER AND MAINTENANCE OF AN EXISTING MOORING BUOY ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

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#### LAND DESCRIPTION

WP 5355

Two parcels of submerged land in the bed of Lake Tahoe, Placer County, California, said parcels being described as follows:

PARCEL 1 - Pier

All that land lying immediately beneath a pier TOGETHER WITH a necessary use area extending 10 feet from the extremities of said pier, said pier being adjacent to that land described in the Grant need recorded June 21, 1984, in Volume 2706, page 390, Official Records of placer County.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary low water mark of Lake Tahoe.

PARCEL 2 - Buoy

A circular parcel of submerged land 40 feet in diameter, adjacent to and waterward of the above described Parcel 1.
