OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION

 The seawater collector line is part of a larger system to carry salt water to the Steinhart Aquarium from the Pacific Ocean. Fresh groundwater intrusions from heavy rains in recent winters reduced water salinity at the aquarium. The seawater collector line assures a continuous supply of sea water to sustain marine lifegat the Steinhart facility.

Advance permission to construct the final pipeline within State property was granted by letter January 11, 1983. Other permitting jurisdictions took similar action. The work was found to be exempt from CEQA as an emergency project (Cal. Adm. Code 15071(c), The pipeline was installed and the staff believes, that it is appropriate to consider the collector line as an exempt project, under 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905, existing facilities.

- The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$100.00.
- This activity involves lands which have NOT 4. been identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. However, the Commission has declared that all tide and submerged lands are "significant" by nature of their public ownership (as opposed to "environmental significant"). Since such declaration of significance is not based upon the requirements and criteria of P.R.C. 6370, et seq., use classifications for such lands have not been designated. Therefore, the finding of the project's consistency with the use classification as required by 2 Ca... Adm. Code 2954 is not applicable.


