## OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- To prevent further erosion of upland residential property, Mr. and Mrs. Mark Gower have placed bank stabilization material consisting of boulders and gravel base along a 100 fook section of the Sacramento River, utilizing land under the Commission's jurisdiction. The Gowers have obtained all the necessary permits required from other agencies. It is therefore recommended that the Commission approve issuance of a General Permit Protective Structure Use for the project.
- The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$50
- of this activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. but will not affect those significant lands.

Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the order review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
