On December 17, 1981, the State Lands Commission approved the issuance of a General Lease - Commercial Use, covering a 6.198-acre parcel of tide and submerged land in Seven Mile Slough, Sacramento County, for a commercial marina, to F. Roy Gustavson dba Owl Harbor.

CURRENT SITUATION:

The lessee is in the process of securing a note for marina improvements through Department of Boating and Waterways.
