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## OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- This is a bank protection project. It is staff's opinion that the project is of mutual benefit to the public and applicant. The strength and integrity of the levee system at the sites should be enhanced without any additional cost to the public. The erosion of the bank, which contributes to the clogging of navigable channels, should be decreased. The alue of the applicant's upland puperty and improvements will be safeguarded to a greater extent from the threat of erosion and flooding.
- 2. The annual mental value of the sites is estimated to be \$85.50.
- 3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Jode 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorical exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 4, Minor Alteration to Land, 2 Gal. Adm. Code 2905(d)(2).
