GENERAL LEASE - GRAZING USE

APPLICANT: Steve Stewart
P. O. Box 284,
Lone Pine, California 93545

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:
258.32 acres, exposed Lako Lands, Owens Lake,
Inyo County.

LAND USE: Cattle Grazing.

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE:
Initial period: 10 years, beginning
December 1, 1984.

CONSIDERATION: \$258.32 for the first year, and a fixed annual
rental rate for the second through the fifth
years, as established by appraisal, and
otherwise subject to the State's five-year rent
review provisions for the balance of the lease.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:
Pursuant to 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2003.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. The lands proposed for grazing were originally the water-covered lakebeds of Owens Lake. They were made dry when the Lake's feeder streams were diverted for water supplies to southern California. The exposed property currently supports limited grazing.
2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorical exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 4, 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905(d)(1).

Authority: PRC 21084, 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15300, and 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2905.

3. This activity involves lands which have NOT been identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. However, the Commission has declared that all tide and submerged lands are "significant" by nature of their public ownership (as opposed to "environmental significant"). Since such declaration of significance is not based upon the requirements and criteria of P.R.C. 6370, et seq., use classifications for such lands have not been designated. Therefore, the finding of the project's consistency with the use classification as required by 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2954 is not applicable.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. FIND THAT THE ACTIVITY IS EXEMPT FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CEQA PURSUANT TO 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15001 AS A CATEGORICAL EXEMPT PROJECT, CLASS 4, 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 21084, 2 CAL. ADM. CODE 2905(d)(1).
2. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO STEVE STEWART OF A 10-YEAR GRAZING LEASE BEGINNING DECEMBER 1, 1984; IN CONSIDERATION OF \$258.32 RENTAL FOR THE FIRST YEAR, AND A FIXED ANNUAL RENTAL RATE FOR THE SECOND THROUGH THE FIFTH YEARS, AS ESTABLISHED BY APPRAISAL, AND OTHERWISE SUBJECT TO THE STATE'S FIVE-YEAR RENT REVIEW PROVISIONS FOR THE BALANCE OF THE LEASE; FOR CATTLE GRAZING ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.
