RESURVEY OF GALLINAS CANAL

APPLICANT:

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State Lands Commission, Division Project

BÁCKGRÓUND:

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Pursuant to an act of the California Legislature approved April 1, 1870, Chapter 388, Statutes 1870, the Board of Tide Land Commissioners surveyed and located Gallinas Canal in the Gallinas Creek area of Marin County and subdivided into lots the unsold salt marsh, tide and submerged lands adjoining Gallinas Canal.

By, Chapter 497, Statutes 1959, the Legislature granted in trust to Marin County all the State's interest in Gallinas Canal and directed the State Lands Commission to survey, map, and describe the granted lands and file a map of the grant with the Marin County Recorder. A survey and map were completed under Work Order 3260 B and a grant map was filed with the county recorder. The grant survey and map is based on two recovered original survey monuments, set by G. F. Allardt, Chief Surveyor for the Board of Tide Land Commissioners.

In 1970, in connection with litigation involving the location of the Gallinas Canal, <u>Wiese vs. State</u>, <u>Marin Superior Court</u> No. 43770, a search was made for additional Gallinas Canal monumentation. A surprising number of original monuments were found, and it became apparent that the canal lines, as positioned by adjustment under Work Order No. 3260 B, required readjustment, and that it is necessary to file a map showing the revised Gallinas Canal location.

Readjustment of the Gallinas Canal lines has been completed and a map entitled "RESURVEY OF GALLINAS CANAL VICINITY OF GALLINAS CREEK, MARIN COUNTY CALIFORNIA" has been prepared,
