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A parcel of tide and submerged land in the bed of the San Joaquin River, San Joaquin County, California, Tying immediately beneath a floating dock TOGETHER WITH a necessary use area extending 10 feet from the extremities of said dock, said dock being adjacent to the left bank of said San Joaquin River and northeasterly of that land described in the deed recorded April 13, River and northeasterly of that land described in the deed recorded, and also 1973, in Book 3755, Page 9, San Joaquin County Official Records, and also being adjacent to Mossdale Trailer Park Space No. 3 and approximately 80 being adjacent to Mossdale Trailer Park Space No. 3 and approximately 80 feet southeasterly of the Interstate Highway 5 bridge over the San Joaquin River.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion thereof lying landward of the ordinary high water mark.
